# MARVELOUS MAY

*by Father Michael*

This month has a whirlwind of activity. As usual, we celebrate First Holy Communions. We had two ceremonies last week, and the final two Masses were this weekend. It is always a joyful time to see all the children on this happy day. Sometimes it can be discouraging to see how many adults do not have a sense of the sacred and sometimes demonstrate behavior that is less than respectful of what we do. But we try our best to welcome, engage, and allow the prayer to be a time of grace for all who are there.

In addition, this year we moved Confirmation from the fall of ninth grade to the spring of eighth grade. This Tuesday, Bishop Robert Coyle will be here to celebrate the Sacrament to almost one hundred of our young people. The prior two years, pastors were given permission to confer the Sacrament because of restrictions coming out of the Covid shutdown. We look forward to this being a spirited day for our young people and their families.

Last Saturday, at one of the First Communions, I was speaking to the children before Mass as they were about to enter. I was complimenting them on how nicely they were dressed. I saw that all the girls were holding small bouquets. I jokingly said that I had forgotten my bouquet. One of the little girls came to me and offered her bouquet—how precious, how marvelous.

I had no intention of watching the coronation last Saturday. But I was up early and turned on the TV. I have to say I found myself being drawn into what was happening. It was not pomp and circumstance that I found engaging, but rather that this state affair was being held in the context of prayer and the Eucharist. It was remarkable how many of their traditions are mirrored in what we do in our worship. In particular, I found the solemn anointing to be powerful. It was reminiscent of the anointing I experienced at my ordination. However, I did think that gold, horse-drawn buggy was a bit over the top. I'm sure I was not alone in watching the festivities.

If you came to the parish during the week over the past two weeks, you probably noticed all the equipment and activity that was happening on our bell tower. If you recall, about six years ago we entered into a lease agreement with Verizon for them to utilize our bell tower as a cell tower. After a few years, all the electronics they originally installed were now outdated and needed to be replaced. It was an enormous project to swap out the old for the new. I am enormously grateful that we have this arrangement. The parish gains over \$3,000 a month in rent for the use of the tower.

# LITURGY BYTES

## Mystagogy - Grow Closer to God




Mystagogy is a Greek word meaning to lead through the mysteries. The CCC (Catechism) describes mystagogy as a liturgical catechesis that aims to initiate people into the mystery of Christ. Many of us are intrigued (I know that I am) by the challenge of a mystery that invites us to solve a crime or a puzzle. However, in Biblical and Church traditions, a mystery is not something we solve. It is something we enter into with God in a sense of wonder, respect, and awe. We accept the mysteries of our faith even though we may not fully understand them.

Recently, at the Easter Vigil, we witnessed some of our parishioners experiencing full initiation into the Catholic Church. They have now entered mystagogy as they continue to grow closer to God and have a deeper understanding of the Catholic faith. I would like to suggest that we, cradle Catholics for the most part, reflect a little on what mystagogy can mean to our lives.

*It is always good to reflect on those experiences we may take for granted that we have been doing or witnessing for many years.* For example, what feelings came to mind watching these adults be baptized at the Easter Vigil as the water was poured over their heads or as they were adorned in the white garment? Perhaps you recently attended a First Communion for a relative or friend. What feelings came over you as a child received Jesus for the very first time? Did you recall how blessed we are to have this privilege each time we attend Mass, or did you recall your own first Communion day and all that it meant to you?

As I mentioned above, it is good to reflect on those things we experience regarding our Faith and our celebration of the Faith. In this "sacramental season," what fills your heart and soul?

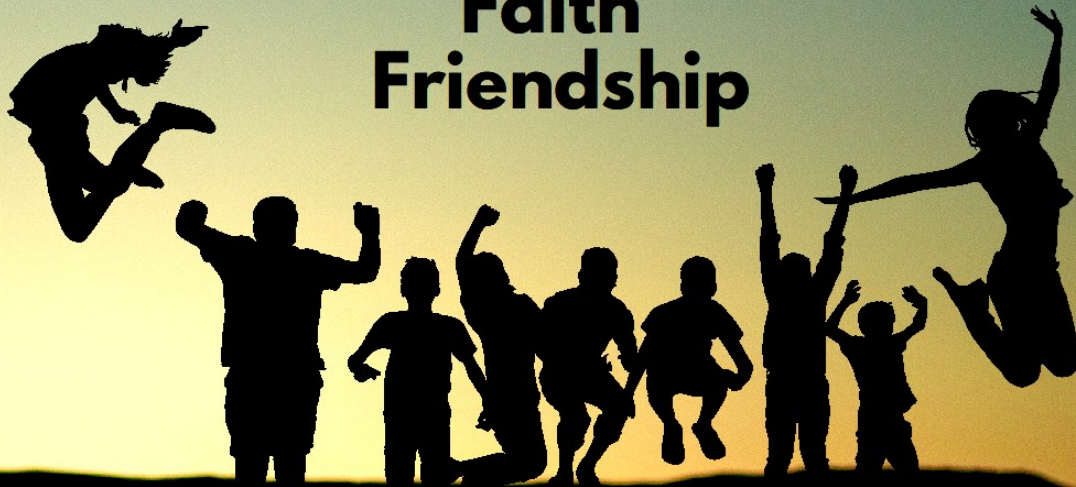

- Increase basic knowledge of mental health to help reduce stigma.
- Understand Mental Health as a continuum of wellness that defines us every day – it is illness, recovery and all of the space in between.

## **Why is this important?**

Consider this: the median time between the onset of mental illness (when symptoms first appear) and when an individual gets appropriate treatment is **10 years**.

During that time, a person is likely experiencing periods of increased symptomology and periods of wellness. Mental Health and recovery are dependent on an individual's ability to recognize and manage where he/she is each day on the continuum between wellness and illness and take care accordingly, an important piece to quality of life. **Education and early intervention promotes wellness.**

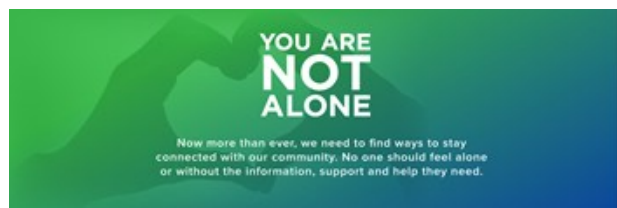

## PARISH OUTREACH



May is Mental Health Awareness Month. If you or a loved one are struggling, you are not alone. There is help. Talk to your primary care doctor or another health professional about mental health problems. Ask them to connect you with the right mental health services. If the situation is potentially life-threatening, get immediate emergency assistance by calling 911, available 24 hours a day. If you or someone you know is suicidal or in emotional distress, contact the 988 Suicide & Crisis Lifeline. Trained crisis workers are available to talk 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. Your confidential and toll-free call goes to the nearest crisis center in the Lifeline national network. These centers provide crisis counseling and mental health referrals.

### Telephone Reassurance



Telephone Reassurance is a FREE program designed to benefit isolated or homebound seniors to provide a safety check or a social chat. All calls are made in the morning, Monday through Friday, from 8:30 AM to 11:30 AM.

These calls are made by RSVP (Retired Senior Volunteer Program), senior volunteers who have been screened and trained. The volunteers work under the supervision of an RSVP staff member and regularly participate in ongoing seminars designed to build skills and gain knowledge of the senior population and community resources.

A brief enrollment form with client information and emergency contacts is all that is needed to begin this free service. Enrollment forms can be found in the Outreach office, or you can call RSVP directly at 631-979-9490 Ext. 21. **All calls are confidential.**

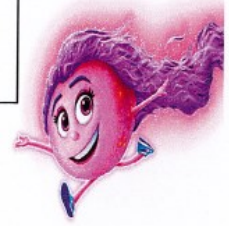
