Happy Mother's Day

May this be a blessed day for all of you who are Moms. May it be a day to rejoice in this calling God has shared with you. Remember to reach out to your own Mom, and in some way offer gratitude for the gift of life and all she has given you. I will make a visit to the cemetery to visit my Mom. I find visiting her grave to be a peaceful time. Although, I must say I was surprised when I went last year, of all the activity that takes place on Mother's Day. The cemetery was certainly full of visitors. There were people who were having picnics around some of the graves, and there was even one group who were singing songs. I have to say my visits are more low-key than that; I usually just stay a few minutes and say a few prayers.

There has been a small project in the back of my mind for years that I have wanted to get done. It has finally made it to the top of the list, and we are ready to proceed. We will be sprucing up our chapel. Currently, there is a variety of colors in that room: forest green carpeting, sky blue walls, burgundy seating, and a black floor. We will be painting and making a few other minor improvements. The work is slated to take place the week of May 20th. During that week, the daily Mass will take place in the Worship Area.

It has been a while since I have reported any animal activity around my house. That is because there really has not been much to report aside from a few squirrels and rabbits. Back in the winter, there was an unfortunate incident when one of the deer that lives in the woods was hit by a car on Nichols Rd. He was one of three, but since then I have not seen any deer. Unexpectedly, one morning this week I looked out the window and saw four foxes playing in my driveway. They were all about the same size. They all seemed to be full grown. I always thought that foxes have short legs, but these guys had long legs. I went to get my phone to take a picture of them, but by the time I got back, they were heading off into the woods.

These have been busy weeks for our Religious Education Office. In addition to celebrating First Communions, our Confirmation candidates have been making their retreat. It is an evening of prayer that is held here at the parish. This year we have Mr. Tony Bellizzi leading the retreats. He is a man who has a great charism in working with youth. The time in which he spends with our youth is engaging and inspiring. There is time for some fun and crazy games, but most of the program is dedicated to leading our young men and women into a deep experience of prayer. We are still awaiting notification from the Diocese as to the date when Confirmation will take place in the fall.

Welcome to Holy Cross Religious Education


The Religious Education Office is planning ahead to the 2019-2020 Formation Year. We need your help so that we can adequately plan to meet the needs of our parish. If you have a child entering **First Grade in September you need to register.** If you have recently moved to our parish you need to register in the parish. Our program is "home based." Classes do not take place at the Church; rather they are held in the homes of our Catechists. Because of this, there are geographical limits on who we are able to accommodate. Please contact our office for more specific information.

- First time registration needs to be done in person at our office.
- Registration needs to be completed by June 14, 2019.
- Office Hours: Monday Friday 9:00-12:00 & 1:00-4:00
- If your child was not baptized at Holy Cross you need to bring a copy of your child's Baptism Certificate.
- For those who are already part of our program, you need to re-register for the upcoming year. Materials will be sent to your home by the middle of May, and they may be returned by mail. Please note the deadline of June 14, 2019.

A detailed outline of our program is available on-line or at our office. But, there are a few important details to be noted.

- Children must successfully complete each grade level to proceed to the next.
- The Sacraments of Reconciliation, Eucharist, and Confirmation require a minimum of two years of preparation.

Most importantly, we need to work together. Faithful attendance at classes and parent workshops is essential. As comprehensive and informative as our program is,



this is only one part of your child's faith formation. The greatest thing you can do to nurture your faith and the faith of your child is to regularly be part of our Sunday Eucharist.

The Catechism of the Church states that parents have the first responsibility for the education of their children. We are privileged to work with you in this task. We thank you for your cooperation in allowing us to be part of your lives. We look forward to a fruitful year where everyone, young and old, continues to grow in understanding the gift of our faith.


Holy Cross Seniors

Depending on how many requests we receive, we will try to include at least one intention per week. It may be necessary to edit the prayer so that its format is consistent with the other prayers.

The Conscience & Religious Freedom office within the Department of Health & Human Services (HHS) was created last year to hear complaints from pro-life medical personnel who claimed they're getting fired or retaliated against for their beliefs. This new office is intended to correct this and to stop what Cardinal Timothy Dolan called the "increasing and fierce attack on conscience rights" in medicine.

In its first year, the new HHS division received 348 complaints about religious or moral discrimination, a significant increase over previous years.

Other issues the office considers are: people who oppose vaccines that are derived from fetal tissue from aborted babies, and medical students who object to being trained to do abortions. Conscience protections for those who oppose doctor-assisted suicide are also a growing concern as more states legalize the life-destroying practice.
