# Happy Mother's Day

*by Father Michael*

Happy Mother's Day to all the good and holy women who take on the role of being mother. I hope this is a day of affirmation from your loved ones. I hope it is a day you are reminded of the special work to which God has called you. It is neither a title you ever outgrow, nor work that you ever complete. This is a bittersweet day for me; my first Mother's Day since my Mom passed away.

My Mom was never a fan of going to a restaurant on Mother's Day; it was too crowded and crazy for her. We used to take turns hosting Mother's Day at one of our homes, or we would bring the meal to her house. However, I do remember one exception to that rule about forty years ago. My Mom loved Chinese food. At the time, my brother-in-law worked in lower Manhattan for the phone company. He would often eat lunch in Chinatown and discovered a great little restaurant. So, that year we all piled into a couple of cars and headed out. Wo-Hop was a tiny hole-in-the-wall restaurant located one flight down on Canal Street. We had to wait on line. The place had orange formica tables. The waiter slid glasses of hot tea down to each of us as he took our orders. The ambiance was border-line sketchy, but the food was spectacular. I think the bill was something like \$35 for eight of us. We only did that one time, but it was a great experience and has become a happy memory.

In general, life here at Holy Cross unfolds in a balanced and manageable way. But, every once in a while things get a little crazy. Last weekend was one of those occasions. In the course of the weekend we had: one funeral, two First Communions, a Holy Hour, Confessions, four regular weekend Masses, the Anointing of the Sick, and Baptisms. I think some of the pews were smoking from overuse by the time Sunday afternoon rolled around. Weekends like this are exhausting, but they are also energizing as we celebrate an abundance of life within the community.

This week I am officially serving as Dean for the first time since I was appointed in the fall. One of the duties of the Dean is to visit the surrounding parishes and review their sacramental record books to ensure that all information is being recorded correctly. It may sound like a trivial thing to do, but there is a wisdom in this requirement. It can be a headache for someone if they are trying to get married in the Church and they cannot get an updated copy of their baptism certificate because thirty years ago someone made a mistake in entering the information into the register. I will be visiting seven parishes this week to complete this work.

Next weekend is Pentecost. Remember to wear something red if you have it.

# RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

## Welcome to Holy Cross Religious Education

The Religious Education Office is planning ahead to the 2018-2019 Formation Year. We need your help so that we can adequately plan to meet the needs of our parish. If you have a child entering **First Grade in September you need to register.** If you have recently moved to our parish you need to register in the parish. Our program is "home based." Classes do not take place at the Church; rather they are held in the homes of our Catechists. Because of this, there are geographical limits on who we are able to accommodate. Please contact our office for more specific information.

- First time registration needs to be done in person at our office.
- Registration needs to be completed by June 15, 2018.
- Office Hours: Monday – Friday 9:00-12:00 & 1:00-4:00
- If your child was not baptized at Holy Cross you need to bring a copy of your child's Baptism Certificate.
- For those who are already part of our program, you need to re-register for the upcoming year. Materials will be sent to your home early in May and they may be returned by mail. Please note the deadline of June 15, 2018.

A detailed outline of our program is available on-line or at our office. But, there are a few important details to be noted.

- Children must successfully complete each grade level to proceed to the next.
- The Sacraments of Reconciliation, Eucharist, and Confirmation require a minimum of two years of preparation.

Most importantly, we need to work together. Faithful attendance at classes and parent workshops is essential. As comprehensive and informative as our program is, this is only one part of your child's faith formation. The greatest thing you can do to nurture your faith and the faith of your child is to regularly be part of our Sunday Eucharist.

The Catechism of the Church states that parents have the first responsibility for the education of their children. We are privileged to work with you in this task. We thank you for your cooperation in allowing us to be part of your lives. We look forward to a fruitful year where everyone, young and old, continues to grow in understanding the gift of our faith.

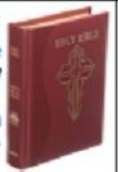
