

Trinity Sunday

by Father Michael

There are several celebrations that follow the Easter Season before we return to Ordinary Time at our Sunday Mass. Last week was Pentecost. Today we celebrate Trinity Sunday. Next week is the Solemnity of the Body and Blood of our Lord. Some of you may have seen me on CFN this week (the Catholic Faith Network for our Diocese). I was the guest of the week on "The Word." It is a 15-minute show in which a homily is given for the upcoming Sunday. That show was recorded so many months ago that I forgot what I said. I will have to watch myself in order to come up with a homily for today.

A number of people have expressed to me that last week's homily was a very positive and prayerful experience for them. That homily was initiated about two months ago at a Stewardship Committee meeting. Some of the ideas that were used came to us from the Conference that the Pastoral Team attended back in March in California. Once the basic idea was discussed, it slowly "percolated" over the next few weeks. When it came time to figure out its implementation, there were many helping hands who planned the music, the PowerPoint presentation and how all the details needed to be tied together, coordinated, and rehearsed. I am most grateful to all those who were part of this collaborative effort.

A few people asked about the song we used. It is entitled "On the Mountain of God" by Lori True. This song is available on several sites on-line. If you listen to most of the versions on-line you will notice that half of the refrain is sung in a Hawaiian dialect. I can't offer any explanation of why the composer originally wrote the song this way. At one point, I was only aware of the Hawaiian version, which would have created a challenge for us to use the song. Happily, it was brought to my attention that there is a full English version, which is what we used. As I said at most of the Masses on the weekend, this is not something we will do every week. But, if there are moments for us to be creative with the intention of deepening our experience of the Eucharist, we will try to do so when those opportunities come along.

We have included some pictures of the parish trip to Niagara Falls, Toronto, and the Thousand Islands in this bulletin. One of the highlights of the tour was the boat ride at the base of the falls. Many of you may know that boat ride as the Maid of the Mist. Actually, there is a new company call Hornblower Tours that now runs those trips. The boats run as close as they can to the base of what is called Horseshoe Falls. We were surrounded on three sides by the water crashing down. It is a simultaneous experience of beauty, solemnity, and fun. Everyone is given a red poncho to wear, but it does little to keep you dry. It is like someone is spraying the garden hose in your face. Although that might sound unpleasant, it is really a remarkable experience. Happily, this was the last thing we did that day before heading back to the hotel where we were able to dry off. We were fortunate enough that each of us had a view of the falls from our hotel room.

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

Welcome to Holy Cross Religious Education

The Religious Education Office is planning ahead to the 2019-2020 Formation Year. We need your help so that we can adequately plan to meet the needs of our parish. If you have a child entering **First Grade in September you need to register.** If you have recently moved to our parish you need to register in the parish. Our program is "home based." Classes do not take place at the Church; rather they are held in the homes of our Catechists. Because of this, there are geographical limits on who we are able to accommodate. Please contact our office for more specific information.

- First time registration needs to be done in person at our office.
- Registration needs to be completed by June 28, 2019.
- Office Hours: Monday Friday 9:00-12:00 & 1:00-4:00
- If your child was not baptized at Holy Cross you need to bring a copy of your child's Baptism Certificate.
- For those who are already part of our program, you need to re-register for the upcoming year. **Materials have been sent to your home in May**, and they may be returned by mail. Please note the deadline of June 28, 2019.

A detailed outline of our program is available on-line or at our office. But, there are a few important details to be noted.

- Children must successfully complete each grade level to proceed to the next.
- The Sacraments of Reconciliation, Eucharist, and Confirmation require a minimum of two years of preparation.

Most importantly, we need to work together. Faithful attendance at classes and



parent workshops is essential. As comprehensive and informative as our program is, this is only one part of your child's faith formation. The greatest thing you can do to nurture your faith and the faith of your child is to regularly be part of our Sunday Eucharist.

The Catechism of the Church states that parents have the first responsibility for the education of their children. We are privileged to work with you in this task. We thank you for your cooperation in allowing us to be part of your lives. We look forward to a fruitful year where everyone, young and old, continues to grow in understanding the gift of our faith.

Every day, people in our community are helped because of support from funds raised through the Catholic Ministries Appeal. Today, consider a dad like Tom.

It was the weekend, and I was at a local bar partying. That was my routine. Apparently, the guy near me was partying harder, and next thing I know we're in a bad fight. And, in that one, heated, drunken moment I lost everything. I was arrested for assault and sentenced to seven years in one of the worst prisons in New York State.



All I could keep thinking was, "This isn't possible. It can't be happening to me." But it was. When I got there, I did everything I could to get out early. I took part in a prison substance abuse program because alcohol had been a mitigating circumstance in my case. I also served as an assistant to a college professor who taught classes for inmates, helping them earn high school diplomas. I loved the work and did that for four years. In the meantime, I trained myself to read a book a day, joined a music program and taught myself to play guitar. But, even with all my good behavior it was still five and a half years before I was released on parole.

When I finally got back home to Long Island, I tried hard to start life over, but it was difficult. Not only did I have to find a job and a place to live, I had to reconnect with family and figure out who my real friends were. To make matters worse, I was unhappy with the outpatient program I had been assigned to. I felt like I was just a number to them, so I took a chance and transferred to Catholic Charities.

The change in atmosphere was like night and day. They had a more spiritual approach and didn't judge me for my past. In fact, they helped me understand that my experiences were valuable life lessons. I finally started feeling good about myself, like I was a part of the community. Today, I work a full time job, have a beautiful family and I haven't had a drink since 2010. It wasn't easy, but the team at Catholic Charities gave me the get-up-and-go I needed to make a fresh start.


