Authority Board Meeting

REU Changes for 2023

Discussion

The Authority has been doing a thorough review of commercial properties and has increased the total REU count by 56 units. The properties have been found lacking the equitable REU factor applied to the accounts. Letters have been sent notifying affected property owners and customers of the changes.

Delinquent List

Discussion

Delinquent amounts increase annually based on rate increases. However, the properties on the list seem to stay relatively constant year after year.

Sherman Lake Project Update

Discussion

The Authority will conduct a final walk through of all properties that connected to sewer with the project contractors within the next 2 weeks. With the September 1, 2023 mandatory requirement for sewer connection, there remains thirteen homes that haven't reached out to the Authority for their sewer connection requirement.
