

Rules for exhibiting models on the Club Stand at Shows

1. All paid up Members have the opportunity to display their models on the Club stand. A member of the committee will ask at the Club night closest to the show who will be attending, and how many models a member will be bringing. Subject to available space and the number of members attending, not all models bought to the show maybe able to be displayed.
2. Exhibits should be at the show in good time to allow the club stand to be set up. Normally this is one hour before the show opens (If the show opens at 10am then members exhibits are needed no later than 9.30 am). If you don't wish to arrive that early, please arrange for a friend or committee member to take your exhibits for you.
3. Models for exhibit should be fully completed, no "work in progress" models unless agreed in advance with the committee.
4. Models should only be exhibited at each show once. (This helps to keep the club stand looking fresh and different.
5. Once on the club stand, models may not be removed until the close of the show. If you wish to enter your model in the competition then it should not be included on the club stand. Where ever possible the committee will advise if competitions are separate from the display stands so you can plan what models you want to enter.
6. All members displaying models on the club stand are expected to take a turn in manning the stand during the show.
