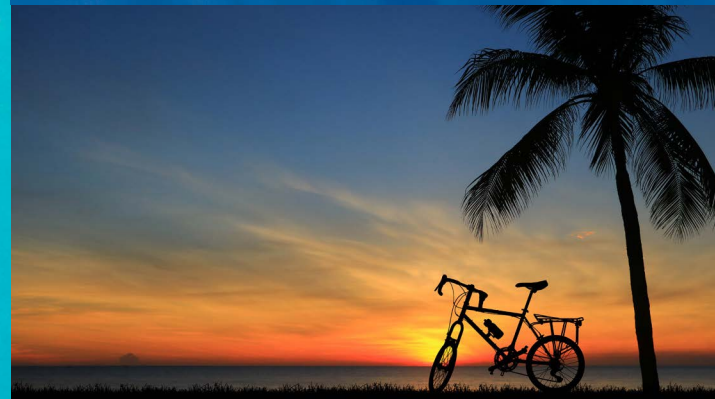
Live like a local

With 120 miles of coastline, Maui boasts red, black, and white sand beaches perfect for a destination wedding or a relaxing day.

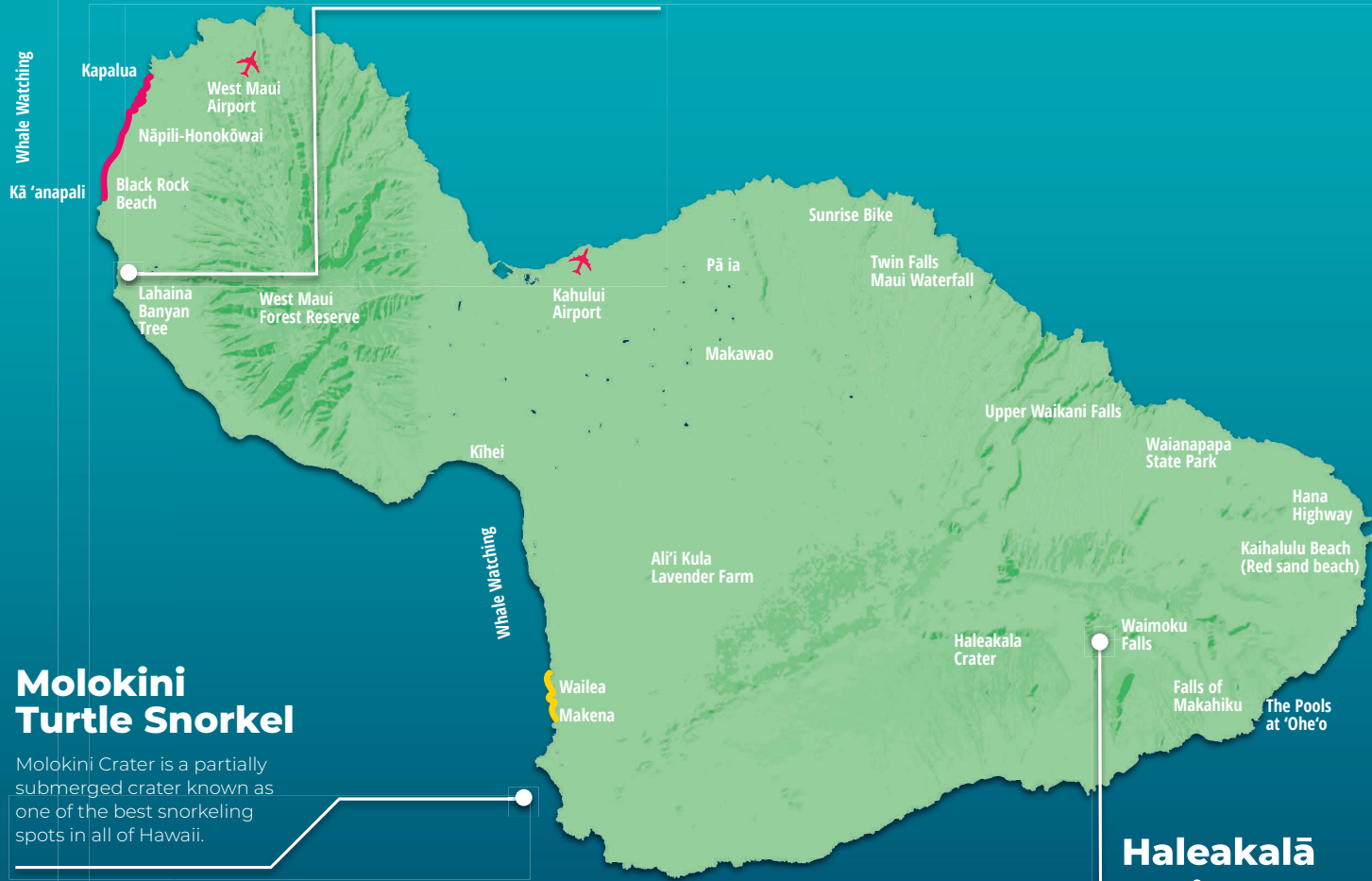


HANA HIGHWAY

This award-winning lū'au features traditional Hawaiian food, hula dancing, and music.

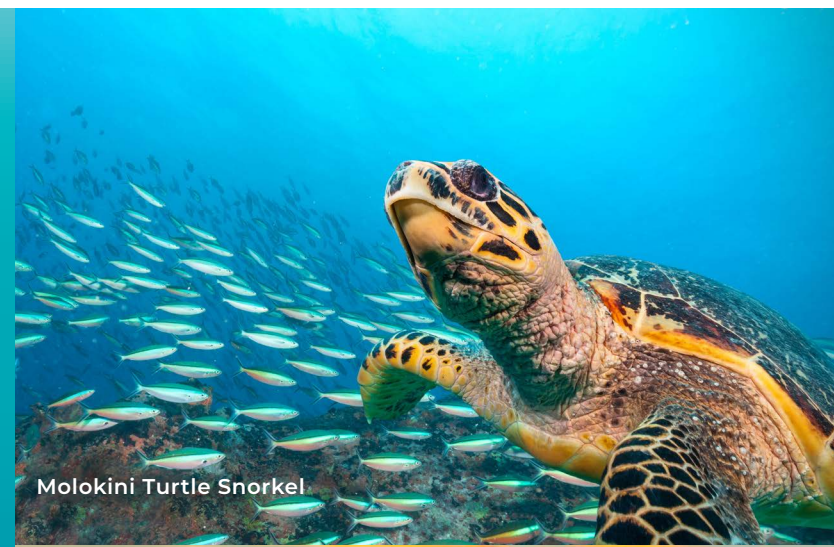


Molokini Turtle Snorkel

Brush up on your backswing and take in the spectacular view at the Ocean Golf Course at Hōkūala on the southeast shore.



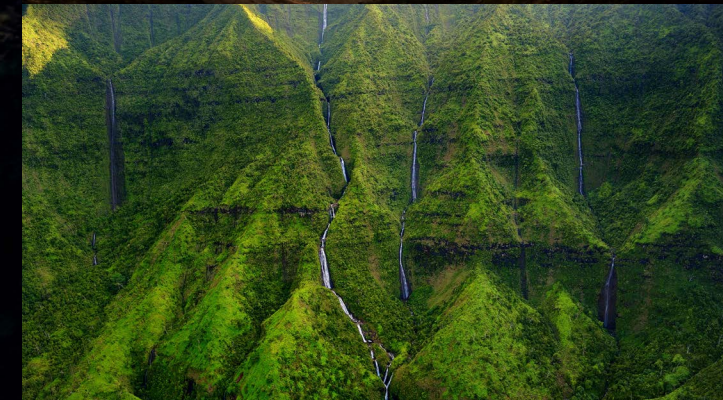
GOLDEN COAST

This small town offers farmers markets and popular arts festivals, along with a 100-year old swinging bridge over the Hanapepe River.

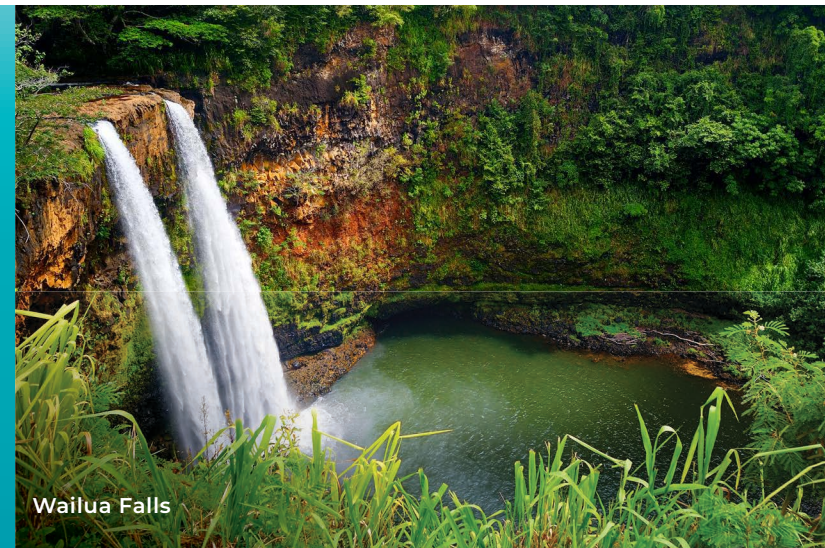


Helicopter tour

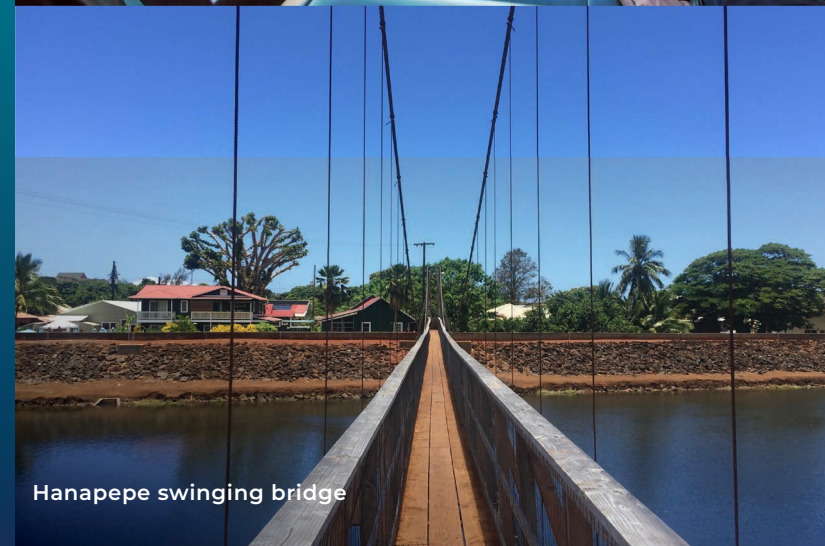

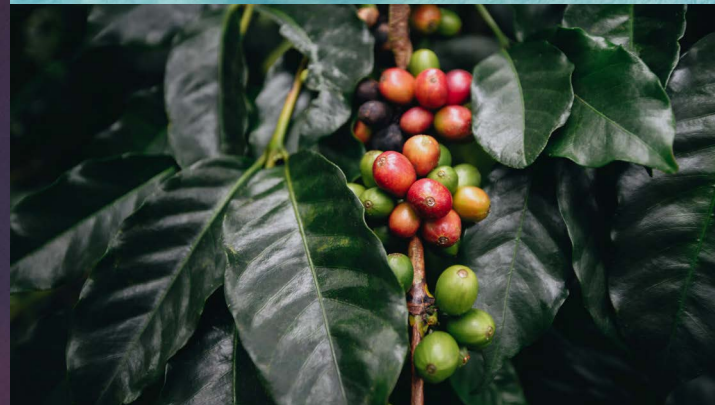
HAWAII

Witness mantas up close as they grace the waters and feed on plankton.

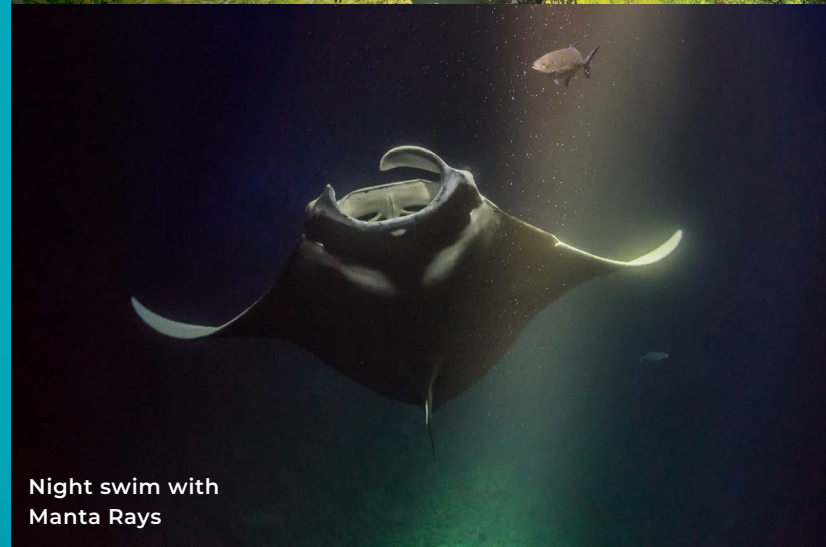
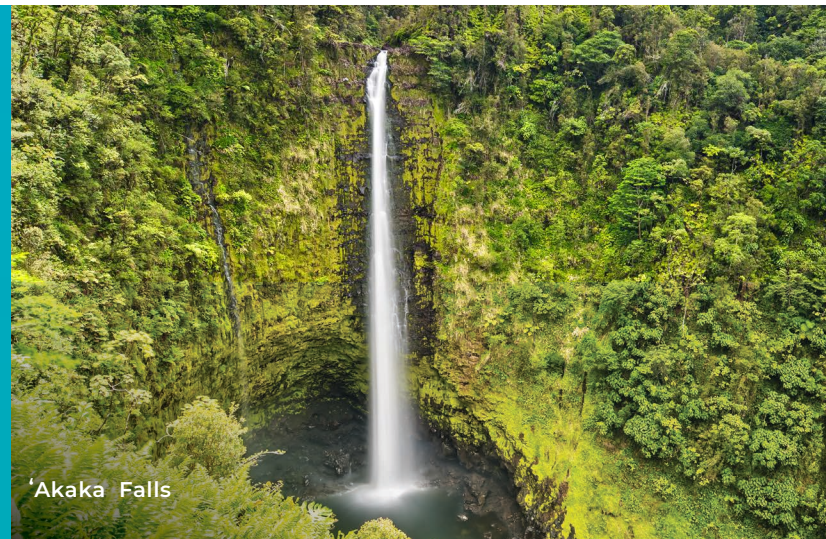

You won't find crowds of tourists on Lāna'i. Many of its quiet beaches, hikes, and viewpoints are only accessible with a four-wheel drive vehicle.

THE GARDEN OF THE GODS (LĀNA'I)

This mysterious rock garden holds towering rock formations. The red soil makes this a spectacular place to watch the sunset.

Ka Hula Piko (Moloka'i)

Moloka'i is the birthplace of hula. This event celebrates the art form with food, storytelling, and of course, dancing.



Hālawā Valley (Moloka'i)

The east end of the island, known as Hālawā Valley, is believed to be the oldest Hawaiian settlement. Waterfalls cascade down each side into hidden valleys.

One of the most recognizable features of Bora Bora is the giant green spire that towers over the landscape.



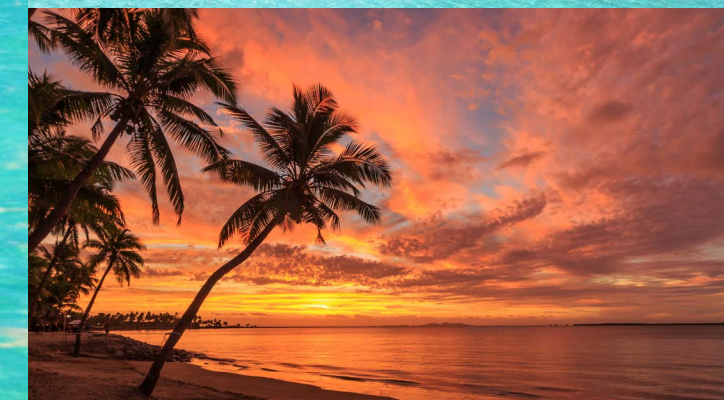

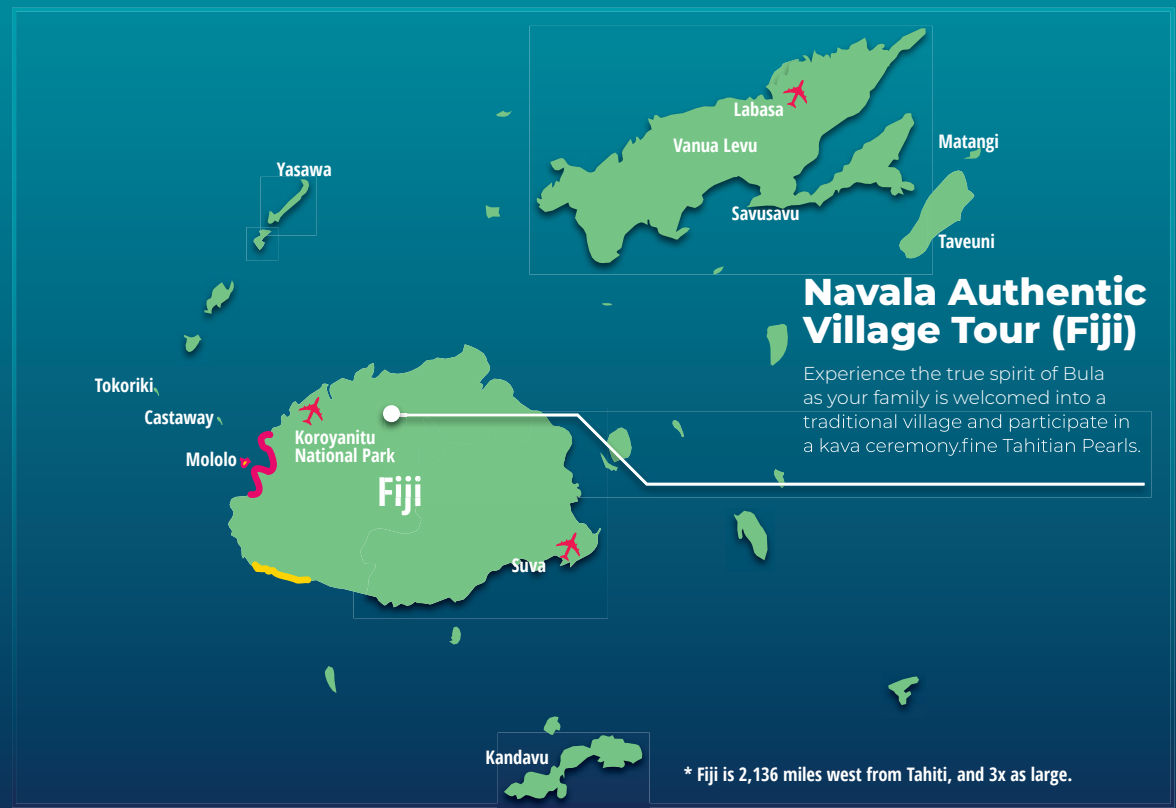

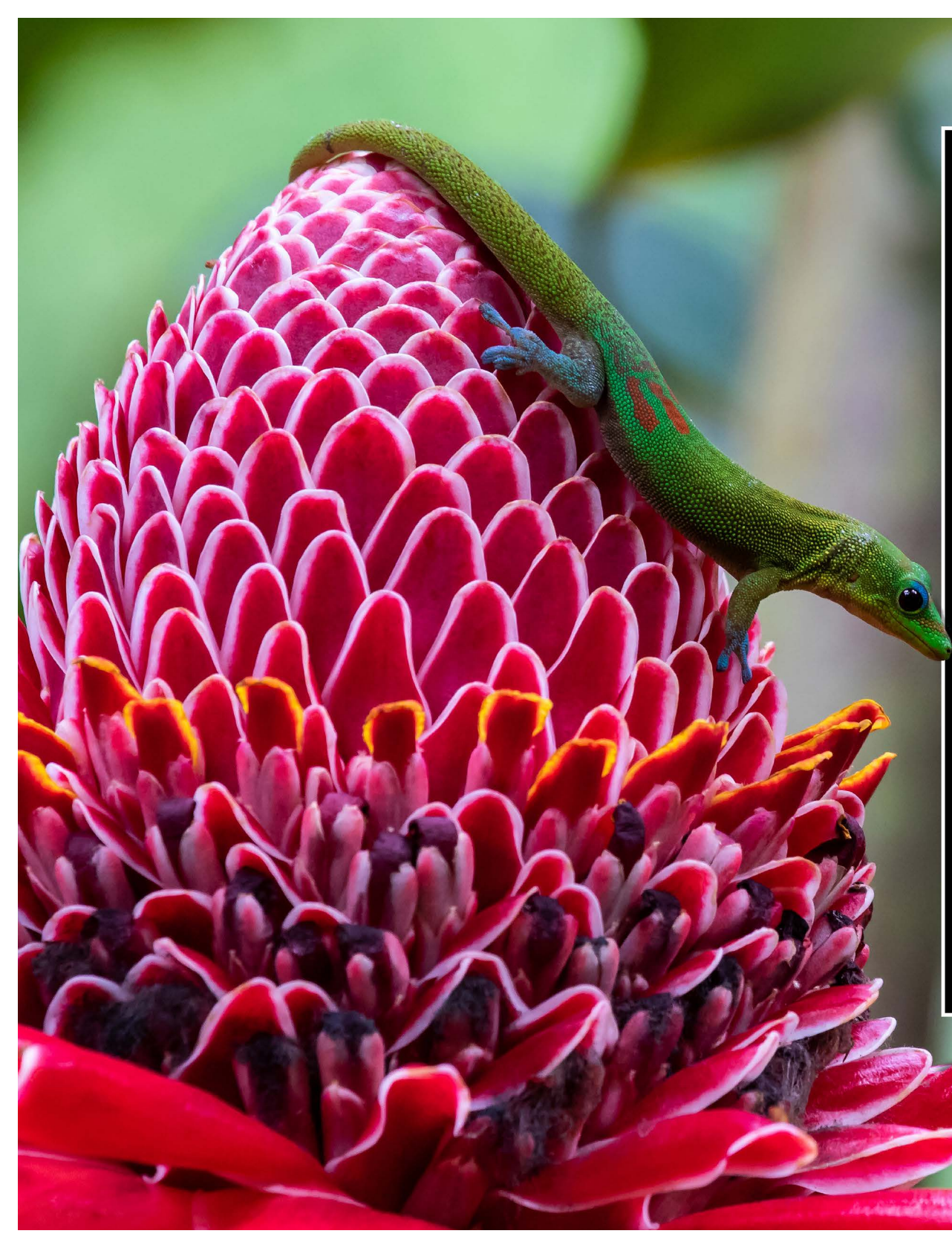
