Changes to MSSA Rules after the 2022 season

- 1. Deleted that the pitcher must have at least one foot touching the pitching rubber when he pitches if using the pitching screen. Can pitch from anywhere in the designated pitching area.
- 2. A teams roster is now 12 players on the field with 5 in the outfield behind the 180 foot shallow play line
- 3. A player willing to play defense would play at least 3 innings of defense per game.
- 4. Senior bats can be used in the 60 and 65 league. Note The 50 league only allows ASA or USA designated bats unless the batter is 65 years old.
- 5. Temporarily injured players (hamstring pull, etc) can request a runner from home plate if approved by the league commissioner.
- 6. Player Misconduct Rules were added to help treat everyone fairly and equally.
