The Pebble Foundation Privacy Policy

The Pebble Foundation (“Pebble”) is committed to protecting your privacy. This policy defines how personal information that we receive from you is collected and treated by Pebble. What information do we collect about you?

We will collect and process personal information from you obtained as a result of your interaction with our website <https://pebblefoundation.org/> (“our site”), attendance at our events, donations to our organization or otherwise as described below. The personal information that you may provide to us, and which we may collect and process, includes your: name, date of birth, country of residence, e-mail address, residential and billing addresses, telephone number, payment information, and message contents, such as comments or questions.

Additionally, we will collect automatically the internet protocol (IP) address used to connect your computer to the internet, your browser type and version, and operating system and platform, as well as information about your visit, including page response times, download errors and page interaction information.

What cookies do we use?

A cookie is a small file of letters and numbers that we store on your browser or the hard drive of your computer. Every time you return to our site, the browser retrieves the cookie and sends it to the site’s server.

Our site does not use cookies to uniquely identify you among other users of our site at this time. We may introduce cookies in the future to help us improve your experience when you visit our site and to improve our site's functionalities, including storing user preferences and tracking user trends.

How do we use the information that we collect from you?

We respect and safeguard the privacy of our users. We will not share your personal contact information with any third party, including other users of the site. We will not sell or rent your personal information to third parties. We reserve, however, the right to use any data that you choose to share with us – or any data about your behavior on our site – for research purposes only. If you do not consent to participate in this research, please do not use our site or services.

By registering and/or donating on the site, you agree to receive e-mail updates and newsletters periodically. Based on the information you provide, Pebble may send you e-mails that pertain to your specific interests. You can choose to opt out of these e-mails through an unsubscribe link within the emails or by contacting us at <https://pebblefoundation.org/contact-us>. If you follow links that take you to other websites, this Privacy Policy no longer applies. Pebble does not control the privacy policies or privacy practices of any third parties.

The site is intended to be used by adults and those who are potential volunteers, partners, or donors.

U.S. Federal law requires parental consent for the collection, use, or disclosure of personal information from children. PEBBLE DOES NOT WANT TO COLLECT ANY PERSONAL INFORMATION FROM THOSE UNDER THE AGE OF 13. Pebble recommends that parents do not post or allow others to post any personally identifiable information with respect to persons under the age of 13.

How do we protect the information that we collect from you?

Confidentiality and security of your personal information are very important to us. Pebble will take appropriate physical, electronic, and other security measures to help safeguard personal information from unauthorized access, alteration, or disclosure and we review our internal security policies and guidelines regularly to ensure. We restrict access to our databases containing personal information to authorized persons on a need-to-know basis and limit retention periods to retain data for no longer than is necessary.

Pebble complies with General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) with respect to any data collected or received from individuals within the European Union (EU) and the European Economic Area (EEA), as well as any data exported to these areas.

Pebble may disclose information upon a good faith belief that access, use, preservation or disclosure of such information is reasonably necessary to satisfy any applicable law, regulation, legal process or enforceable governmental request.
