Participants must be older than 18 years old and live in the selected community for at least three months.**





- Cultivate long term relationships with residents and between residents.
- Co-create a space where neighbors can gather and share thoughts about what they would like to see within the community.



Understanding What's Important

- Learn and understand the history of the community and residents perspectives.
- Listen to what concerns or issues are affecting residents and how they affect them.
- Identify residents interests and passions.



Residents are Experts

- Recognize that residents are the experts of their own lives and are the individuals who live their own day to day experiences.
- Rather than prescribing a solution we ask residents what they need.
