Proven Process

Part I: Closed, open and magic "e" syllables, understanding complex consonant sounds such as "schwa", and short and long vowel sound patterns provide skills for decoding the most difficult English words; vowel-based syllable division enables reading fluency.

Part II: Vowel team syllables, "r" control syllables, consonant "le" syllables, and diphthong syllables provide more advanced decoding skills in preparation to start developing fluency and comprehension skills.

Employees read and comprehend workplace charts, instructions, safety signs, policies and procedures with ease. They talk to and understand others with ease. They read aloud and speak with clear pronunciation. They no longer struggle and spend time trying to sound out words.



Comprehension and Fluency Program

Proven Process

Part I: Pre-reading discussion covers new subject matter in the context of employees' experiences to facilitate understanding of new vocabulary; discussion of word division and meanings make reading new material much easier.

Part II: Pre-reading, key words, webbing and news flash; the pre-reading strategy is still the primary strategy used in the second half of this program. It is, however, augmented by the use of key word, webbing and news flash strategies, which also develop comprehension and fluency skills.

Benefits

Employees obtain a higher level of proficiency in all forms of communication required for supervisory and management positions; reading fluency improves, which enables employees to become automatic readers (automaticity) and eliminates the need for interpretation.
