May 5, 2024, 6th Sunday of Easter (Acts 10:25-26, 34-35, 44-48; 1Jn 4:7- 10; Jn 15:9-17)

"As the Father loves me, so I also love you. Remain in my love." There is no doubt about this theme which the gospel confirms. The most loved and quoted statement in the bible restates the same idea: "God so loved the world that he gave his only Son, so that everyone who believes in him might not perish but might have eternal life." St. Paul is so convinced of God's indomitable love for us that nothing can separate us from God's love that he says: "For I am convinced that neither death, nor life, . . . [nothing here on earth] will be able to separate us from the love of God in Christ Jesus our Lord" (Rom 8:38-39). Nothing in human history parallels Jesus' love for us and His sacrificial death which made possible our salvation. This action established a bond of friendship with us.

Likewise, we are called to establish a friendship with each other in answer to His commandment, "Love one another as I have loved you."

Such sacrificial love leads to joy. Pope Francis says that joy does not mean living from one laugh to another. It arises from a deep-rooted love within us from the presence of Jesus in our hearts. When we emulate Him, we find joy. God is our love and our joy. If we do not love, we cannot have Him, we cannot have joy. We experience more joy in giving than in receiving.

I remember reading long ago a novel, the title and author of which I have forgotten. One night, its protagonist, who was living alone in his house, started crying loudly. He explained to his neighbors who came to comfort him that he had worked hard all his life and turned all his wages into gold coins, even at the expense of his basic needs. Every day after work, he counted and buried them in a chest under his bed. But on that day, he found pebbles, instead of gold coins in it. One of his neighbors told him that now he could count pebbles instead of gold coins and asked what difference does it make? The gold coins were not useful to anyone, not even to him.

The usefulness of life is in loving others. It is love for God and for one another that inspired St. Teresa of Calcutta to help the poor and needy. The same love led St. Maximillian Kolbe to volunteer his life in place of a stranger's in Auschwitz. St. Peter Damian remained in VACTION BIBLE SCHOOL God's love by staying with lepers and died as one of them. These and others like them made Jesus their friend and remained in His love.

Dear friends, we all need to be filled with that same love to be the best, whether a good husband, wife, parent, teacher, physician, clergy, or whatever our position. We need Jesus and His love to live our lives meaningfully. Let us work to strengthen this bond of friendship to live our lives joyfully.
