## HISTORY OF EARLY CHILDHOOD EDUCATION

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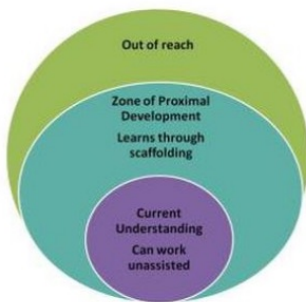


Jean Piaget

There was three well known Theorists that has insight regarding children's develop. Jean Piaget theories are on the cognitive development. Which suggest takes place during social and physical environment. Piaget has cognitive four stages of Development.

1.Sensorimotor Stage birth-2years, 2.Proportional Stage 2-7 years, 3. Concrete Operational Stage 7-11 years, 4.Formal Operational Stage 12-16 years.

### Zone of Proximal Development



Lev was a Russian theorist who was known for this Social Development Theory. Vygotsky's social development theory asserts that a child's cognitive development and learning ability can be guided and mediated by their social interactions. He also claimed that we are born with four elementary mental functions which are attention, Sensation, Perception, and Memory.

He was a Russian Theorist that moved to USA when he was 6 years old. His theory is known as the Ecological Systems Theory. Which later renamed to Bioecological Model. Bronfenbrenner states that there are many levels of contexts or systems that influence the developing child.



There is 5 types of systems

- Microsystem =is the direct environment in which people live.
- Mesosystems=involves the relationship or connections between the Microsystems in person's life.
- Exosystem=is a connection between the environment in which a person does not have an active role
- Macrosystem is a person's culture
- Chronosystem refers to a persons unique history.

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
