



A NEW FALL TRADITION

"We want a fun event that has music, entertainment, food trucks, and everything else that a small-town festival has to offer." So said the residents of Columbia, whom Kelli Johnson of Columbia Main Street credits as the inspiration for the city's 1st annual Fall Fest, which will take place on September 30th on the Town Square.

"It's going to be from 3–7 pm on that Saturday," adds Johnson, who works as a Manager for Columbia Main Street, a nationally accredited Main Street Community organization that serves as a liaison between the city and the downtown area and "is charged with keeping our downtown up-to-date and relevant," as she puts it.

Naturally, the events at the inaugural Fall Fest will be decidedly fall-geared, with the Kiwanis of Columbia's chili cookoff the only ticketed event at the otherwise free festival.

"There is going to be a stage where we'll hold the chili cookoff," explains Johnson. "For ten dollars, you get to sample the chili from all the different teams, and you get to vote on your favorite chili. We will also have a crafts area where we will have local vendors selling handcrafted items. Everything will be fall-inspired, whether it's candles and home accessories or desserts and other baked goods."

There will also be a "fun zone" that offers a little something for all ages, including face painting, balloon artists, inflatables, and even axe-throwing.



Last but not least, the event will also feature live music, with local musicians performing from 3 until 5:30 pm. Then at 5:30, Nashville-based Journey tribute band Majestic will take the stage, performing Journey hits like "Don't Stop Believin'," "Any Way You Want It," "Open Arms," and "Wheel in the Sky," among many others.

"People are encouraged to bring a chair if they want to sit and listen. But we would love to see dancing in the streets," says Johnson, before noting that the Town Square will be closed to motor vehicle traffic for the event, making Fall Fest pedestrian-friendly.

"Wear comfy shoes and bring the entire family. We want everyone from babies to grandmothers here. We are not selling alcohol, so it is truly geared toward families. My family lives here, and this is how we are going to kick off fall," notes Johnson, who grew up in Columbia and chose to stay after she graduated from college.

"Columbia has come so far since I was born. I have so much pride and get so excited when people come from out of state, and I get the chance to show them around," she adds, opining that Columbia has "nailed it on the head recently" when it comes to its focus on families and small businesses.

That said, Fall Fest is one of many events Columbia is hosting in the coming months. One day earlier (Friday, September 29th), it's the 4th annual Room at the Inn Oktoberfest at Riverwalk Park on Riverside Drive, which is set to feature live music, food trucks, and beer tasting.

Then in October, the non-profit A Worthy Cause hosts its annual block party, featuring more live music and food trucks, not to mention local vendor shops and a variety of activities for the whole family.

Events like these only add to the southern charm that Columbia has long embodied, a spirit that has been accentuated by the redevelopment and growth of the downtown area.

"You couldn't re-create our downtown in any other place because all our businesses are special and unique to us," notes Johnson. "We have the historical charm that a lot of southern towns tore down. Having our homegrown retailers in historic buildings is the perfect matchup. It's like a Hallmark movie, but we get to live it daily.

Jimmy Dugger has spent nearly three decades helping people find the perfect home. He considers his work as a longtime Columbia realtor not just a job, but a way to change lives.

"I want to give people a place to go home to. And if you've got the right place, Mama's happy, Daddy's happy, and the kids are happy. And that's all that matters to me."

He's a Maury County native who grew up in Culleoka. He began working full-time for Crye Leike Realtors in 1996 and has a reputation for doing whatever it takes to serve his clients. His track record speaks for itself; he's closed on more than 2100 homes. And while he's an expert on Middle Tennessee, he's familiar with the entire state with closings in 41 of Tennessee's 95 counties.

He says the key to finding someone the right home is to listen to what they tell you.

"I ask a lot of questions. The first thing is minimum requirements. What are you looking for with bedrooms, bathrooms, square footage, and garage capacity? What's your budget? I don't want to show someone a house they can't afford. And then, I ask about the geographic area. If you get down to those three basic questions, that gets you where you need to be in terms of inventory."

It's important, he says, for people to know ahead of time how much "house" they can afford.

"You need to go ahead and get a pre-approval letter, or if you're a cash buyer, be able to prove you have the cash available. This way, when we find the right property, we'll have the money in

position, the inventory in position, and we can do the realtor stuff that makes us who we are. And that's the pixie dust of writing contracts."

Dugger has seen a lot of ebbs and flows through the years. He survived the housing market crash of 2008 and has watched, more recently, as the influx of people moving to Tennessee caused the market to explode.

Nashville's rapid growth has trickled down to surrounding counties creating what he calls a "doughnut" effect. With Nashville in the middle, outlying counties have become the next "tier "or place to move.

"If you look at Nashville and the way it used to be, everybody went to Nashville to do their thing. Now the counties that surround it are the contiguous counties, the counties that touch, and the doughnut has become stronger than the hole. I've watched as the Williamson County's come down to us, and now, we're "tier 2" on that because of people spreading out."

He says Maury County is also feeling a push from the South. "We've not only become tier 1 or tier 2 to Nashville, we're tier 2 to Huntsville. If you look at the two 'doughnuts' as they come together, and the I-65 corridor that makes up the Nashville to Huntsville corridor, we're smack in the middle of that. We're growing like crazy because of it."

With housing in such high demand, finding a realtor you can trust is essential.



THE WHOLE HOG FESTIVAL

Plans have been in the works for months, and organizers say everything is just about ready for this year's John Maher Builders Whole Hog Festival in Spring Hill. Mark your calendars for Saturday, October 7th.

The family-friendly event is held on the grounds of the historic Oaklawn Mansion and serves as a fundraiser for The Well Outreach. Ribeye Steak, Tomato and Mushroom Kebabs

TOTAL TIME: 30 MINUTES

INGREDIENTS:

2 CLOVES GARLIC

1/2 SMALL BUNCH ITALIAN (FLAT-LEAF) PARSLEY

1/4 CUP O ORGANICS EXTRA-VIRGIN OLIVE OIL

1/8 CUP RED WINE VINEGAR

2 TEASPOONS O ORGANICS DIJON MUSTARD

1/2 TEASPOON SALT

1/2 TEASPOON BLACK PEPPER

3/4 POUND O ORGANICS RIBEYE STEAK

1/2 PINT O ORGANICS GRAPE TOMATOES

1/4 POUND O ORGANICS WHITE MUSHROOMS GREEN PEPPER, SLICED (OPTIONAL)

1/2 MEDIUM RED ONION

6 SKEWERS



DIRECTIONS:

Peel and mince garlic. Wash and dry parsley. Shave leaves off stems; discard stems and mince leaves.

In large bowl, whisk minced garlic, half the minced parsley (reserve remainder for garnish), olive oil, vinegar, Dijon mustard, salt and pepper.

Cut steak into cubes; transfer to marinade bowl and toss to coat.

Wash tomatoes, mushrooms and green pepper. Halve mushrooms. Add tomatoes, mushrooms and green pepper to marinade. Peel onion and cut into chunks; add to marinade. Toss beef and vegetables until well coated.

Heat grill pan, outdoor grill or skillet to medium-high heat.

Thread steak and vegetables onto six skewers.

Cook kebabs in batches until steak is browned and vegetables are tender, 3-5 minutes per side. Transfer to plate and repeat with remaining kebabs.

To serve, plate kebabs and sprinkle with remaining minced parsley.


