Compensation: The hourly rate of pay for this creative and fun, part-time, low-stress, independent contractor position is \$15, which leaves room to grow over time. As a part of your compensation, you will receive a 50% discount on all wellness services offered at The Joyful Life that are provided by LeJoy Nichols. Each contractor can also use the workshop as a place to create their personal, creative projects. (Just clean up after yourself.) The supplies used must be purchased at rates provided upon request.

Responsibilities:

Assist in the planning of therapeutic art workshops by making suggestions.
 Provide guidance and support to participants during art projects; offering encouragement and guidance as needed.

- Help create an environment where participants feel safe to express artistic creativity. Assist with set up, clean up, and organization of supplies and materials.
- Be willing to teach or facilitate a workshop on your own when occasionally needed. You will never be given a theme you aren't comfortable with to guide on your own.
- Collaborate with and assist fellow facilitators; making constructive suggestions to adjust activities as needed. I expect the proper candidate to be flexible and to accept change if it helps make things run better. I also expect the proper candidate to suggest changes to the logic of the workshop space as it's revealed with use.
- Adhere to logical safety protocols and procedures to ensure the well-being of participants and staff.
- Provide administrative support as needed, such as (but not limited to) taking workshop pictures, adding
 information and images to the website, keeping records of art/crafts supplies, rewards program data entry
 for workshop participants, and assistance with social media posts to encourage active client interaction,
 referrals, and the attraction of additional clients.

Qualifications:

- A degree of any kind is not required, but a reasonable and basic knowledge of and experience with arts and crafts skills is important. A love of arts and/or crafts is a must.
- A willingness and ability to help prepare for and clean up before and after workshops.
- Strong understanding of at least one art technique, familiarity with basic art materials, and the ability to suggest, adapt to, and learn new creative activities.
- Excellent interpersonal and communication skills, with the ability to establish rapport and trust with workshop participants and peers.
- A compassionate nature with a genuine desire to facilitate creativity through arts and crafts projects.
- Ability to work effectively as part of a small team and a willingness to collaborate with colleagues from diverse backgrounds, ethnicities, sexual orientations, etc.
- The proper candidate will need to be willing to help with program planning, social media promotion, and communication with clients who ask questions or concerns by phone, through the website, GoDaddy Conversations, Facebook Messenger, Gmail, etc.
