Goals of the project



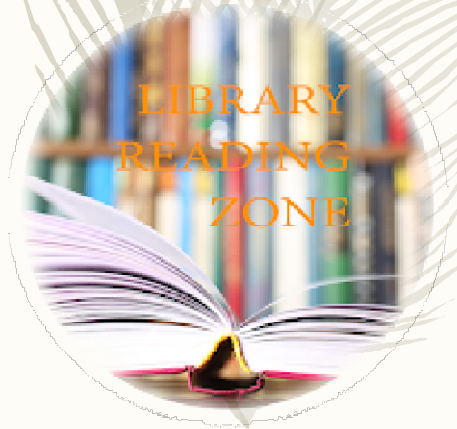
- ❖ To create uniquely designed and modernized libraries that include adequate book collections, technology, and other media, to develop supportive, welcoming and learner-centered environments.

Our Solution



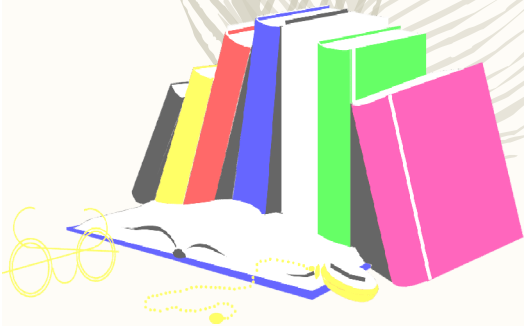
This is where The Library Project comes in.

We include beautiful books that teach all students about the Success and Failure life journey of Dr Kalam sir beautiful world in which we live.

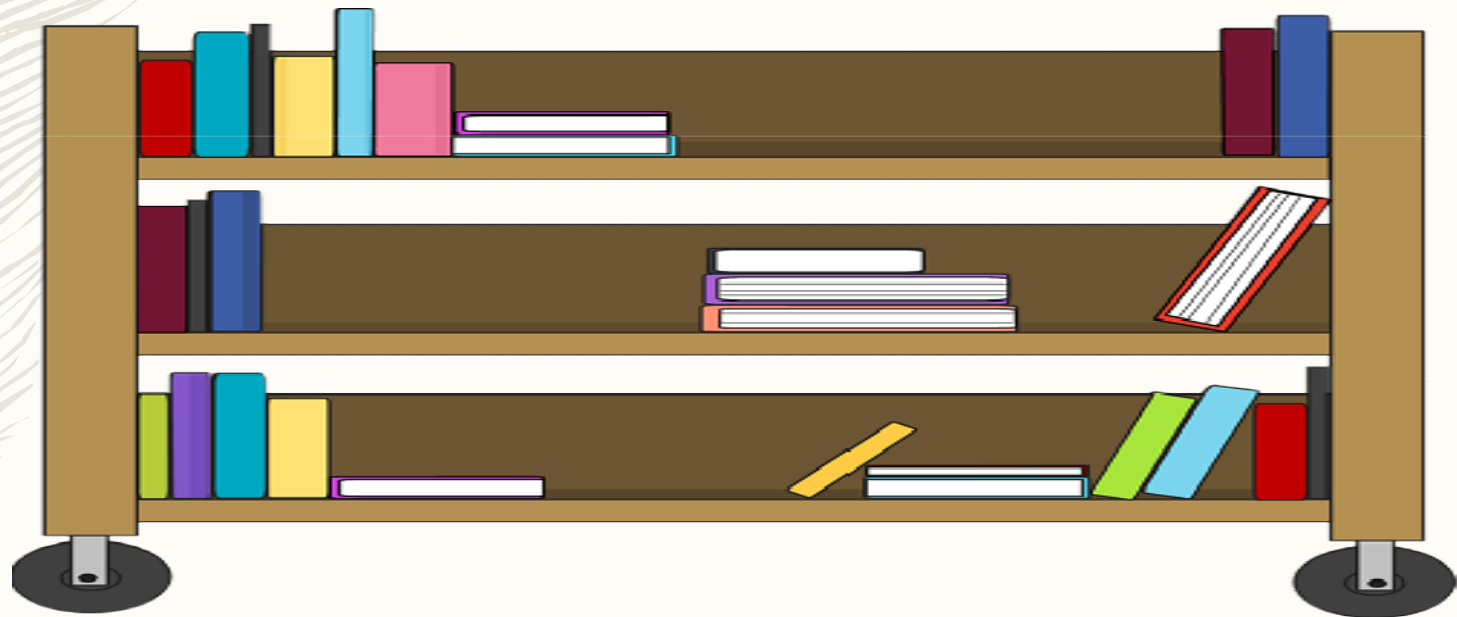
We also conduct children's literacy programs in rural elementary schools. Literacy Programs allow us to expand on our donation, to show children in rural schools just how exciting reading can be.
