Evidence of signing under protest and duress

Defendant will enter a plea of nolo contendre to Amended Count 1 Conspiracy to Possess a Firearm with a Prior Disgualifying Conviction. specifically a crime of violence, in C-08-CR-22-652.

State will dismiss other charges in C-08-CR-22-652 and C-08-CR-23-122 in its entirety. The State will not use the incident that is C-08-CR-22-652 as a basis to violate the defendant's probation in K13-884.

Court will agree to sentence the defendant to no greater period of active incarceration than eighteen (18) months. Any additional suspended time, as well as the terms and conditions of any probation, are in the Court's discretion.

There is no other sentencing limitation except that provided by law.
