



POWER WHEELS

AGE GROUPS: 4-8 AND 9-11

Definition of power wheels: Any regular electric Power Wheel is allowed. NO 4-wheeler, bikes, motorcycles, dirt bikes, or tractor types of vehicles allowed because legs are exposed. We do not allow adult size 4-wheelers, go-karts, mini bikes, drift trikes, tractors, side by sides, bikes, etc. If the ride on toy has legs exposed, we will not allow them to compete.

BUILD RULES

1. Vehicles are allowed UP TO a 12-volt lawn mower battery, which cannot be mounted in the passenger seat. Battery must remain secured and sealed away from child.
2. Doors can be strapped shut. It is recommended but not required.
3. Tires can have rubber screwed onto the factory tire, but we will not allow any other modifications. No chains, no rubber tires, no aftermarket tires, etc.
4. No purposeful sharp edges on the vehicles.
5. No added reinforcements for strength allowed.
6. Decorative changes can be made to the vehicle to make it look like a derby car – however it cannot reinforce the power wheels.
7. Bumpers must be plastic. No metal bumpers allowed.

SAFETY RULES

1. **All participants must be wearing a helmet.** This can be a bike helmet.
2. Belts are highly recommended, but not required.
3. Power wheels drivers must stay in the vehicle at all times and keep all hands and feet inside their vehicle. Leaving the vehicle or putting feet outside are grounds for disqualification.
4. Please bring your child in close toed shoes.
5. Sit IN not ON the vehicle.
6. A parent/guardian must accompany the child at ALL times.
7. Participants will not be allowed to compete until completing safety inspection and signing of liability waivers by their parent/guardian.

8. All parents and drivers need to be present at the driver's meeting at 5:45PM.

DEMOLITION DERBY RULES:

1. PLEASE ARRIVE FOR INSPECTION before 5:15PM for inspection and balloons. This will be at the Herriman Rodeo Grounds.

2. Balloons will be provided to attach to front and rear of vehicle.

3. Object is to pop or remove other contestants' balloons.

4. The last one left with a balloon is the winner.

CONDITIONS:

Each participant will receive a goodie bag for participating, and first place winner will receive a medal or trophy for each age group. After the power wheel's heat, the designated Wrecked Neck Racing Team Member will guide you and your child back to the pit area to place power wheels back in your vehicle. After that, we ask that all children stay with their parent/guardian either in the pit area, or pit seating by the arena for the remainder of the show. Adult sized cars will be going in and out of the arena throughout the night, as well as heavy duty equipment, and we want to minimize and reduce the risk for any and all injuries. If we see an unaccompanied child, or children running around in the back, we will ask you to relocate or leave. No warnings will be given. Safety is priority.

All registration is non refundable and non transferrable.
