

CCA Vocational Ministry Scholarship

Scholarship Description:

This scholarship is provided to cover a portion of tuition for families who have exemplified the mission of Chicago Christian academy through a commitment to evangelism and discipleship in their daily life and work. Those who have gone above and beyond to advocate for the specific mission of Chicago Christian academy will be considered with greater weight. Applicants may apply for a maximum of \$4,500 in scholarship funding per enrolling student. This cannot be combined with financial aid.

Mission Statement:

We exist to partner with parents in the discipleship of their children by providing academic instruction that is distinctly Christian, inspiring a wonder at God and a love of His creation; by equipping a generation of critical thinkers ready to engage the world using the proven classical education methods and liberal arts tradition; and by fostering a diverse fellowship of support and love through intentional and robust engagement with attending families.

Requirements:

- A career in vocational ministry
- A knowledge of the Gospel of Jesus Christ and an ability to effectively communicate it
- A regular pattern of evangelism and discipleship
- A previous application for financial aid through our partner BeneFAQ

Application Questions:

1. What is your vocation and how long have you held this position?
2. How would you explain the Gospel?
3. How often do you practice evangelism via verbal sharing of the Gospel?
4. How do you see yourself living out the spirit of the CCA mission in your own life and work?
5. How have you advocated specifically for Chicago Christian Academy and how do you plan to continue (fundraising, prayer letters, volunteering, networking, etc.)?
6. How much scholarship are you applying for?
7. Please detail why you are applying for this scholarship and how this tuition coverage would help your family.
