Our History



The Fountain Church emerged from a Spirit-filled idea by pastors of Eau Claire Wesleyan Church and Red Cedar Church in Rice Lake, during a time of strong church planting focus in Wisconsin. Beginning with prayer meetings in January 2009 at Bob and Michelle Ritter's home, Pastor Matt Ohime, previously of Eau Claire Wesleyan, joined these sessions. He accepted the call to lead The Fountain full-time in August 2010.

By September, The Fountain launched officially in the Bloomer Middle School auditorium. Purchasing 1320 N. Industrial Drive in February 2014, our church family worked together to create a space for worship, kids' programs, and youth groups. We held our inaugural service in our current building in July 2014. Pastor Ohime and family departed for Indiana in August 2017. At this time, Pastor Scott Sacrey stepped in to lead The Fountain's next chapter.

As we look ahead, we are already in prayer for the pastor who will lead our future, listening for God's guidance on what's to come.

Our Community

Northern Chippewa County is a peaceful rural community nestled in the heart of Wisconsin. Geographically you'll find us located approximately 100 miles east of Minneapolis, MN and 200 miles northwest of Madison, WI.

Inclusive of 4 quaint, welcoming small towns – Bloomer, New Auburn, Cornell and Holcombe – our community features sprawling forests and productive farmlands. Manufacturing and farming are the area's two most prominent industries.

Its rich historical roots offer museums, historic markers, and tours that include a glimpse of the past. One of the most prominent features is the County Forest containing approximately 34,500 acres in the northern 1/3 of the County; it hosts nearly all 22-mile of the national scenic Ice Age Trail.

Northern Chippewa County is a place of outdoor adventure boasting some of the highest rated mountain bike, cross country ski, horseback, and ATV trails in the state.

Biblical Authority

Organization

01 CHURCH BOARD The Fountain is governed by our own local board of administration, chaired by the Pastor. Each board member is voted in by the congregation and together are responsible for discerning and carrying out the will of God for The Fountain church, and are encouraged to demonstrate their life in Christ as set out in the Book of Discipline. Board members are voted on annually during our May all church meeting.

The Fountain is 100% self-sustaining.

Our General Operating Budget is the budget that accounts for all expenses to both operate the church and fund our ministries; with a fiscal year running from June 1 to May 31.





Why We Give
