- · Choose the play(s) you'd like to paint a panel (canvas) for.
- Come up with an idea for what to paint. If you search online for the play's title, you will find plenty of images to work with.
- Choose a day and time that the MCL Grand is open to work in Classroom 3. Let the office know you are coming so they can have the classroom and closet unlocked for you.
- The canvas panels will be gessoed over and will be in the VAL closet. Get out an easel for your panel, put a plastic cloth down on the floor and any table you will use. These materials along with paints and brushes can be found in the closet for your use. Use acrylic paint for fast drying.
- Generally, it will take about 3 4 hours to complete a panel. Allow to dry, then transport to the Greater Lewisville Community Theater just down the street at 160 W Main St. There is usually someone there in the afternoons, but call first to make sure and let them know you're coming.
