
I look forward to seeing everyone participate in this event and know that the benefits gained by all will inspire and promote the strongest team spirit possible at our TaeKwonDo Academy.

How the Inner-School Friendship Championship is Organized

Each belt category will be divided into groups of four. Each separate group of four will compete within itself. The four members of each group will be judged in four performance categories: Best Performance (I), Superior Performance (I) and Excellent Performance (2). Each member of the group will receive a medal and a certificate. For example, if we have I6 No Belt students registered, then we will make four groups of four. We have a goal of at least four or more groups of four (minimum of 3, maximum of 5) in each rank category. As much as possible, the groups will be further divided by age, height, gender and ability. It is very important that everyone fill out the entry form completely and register as soon as possible so that we can organize the championship better. If anyone has any questions, please ask your instructor.
