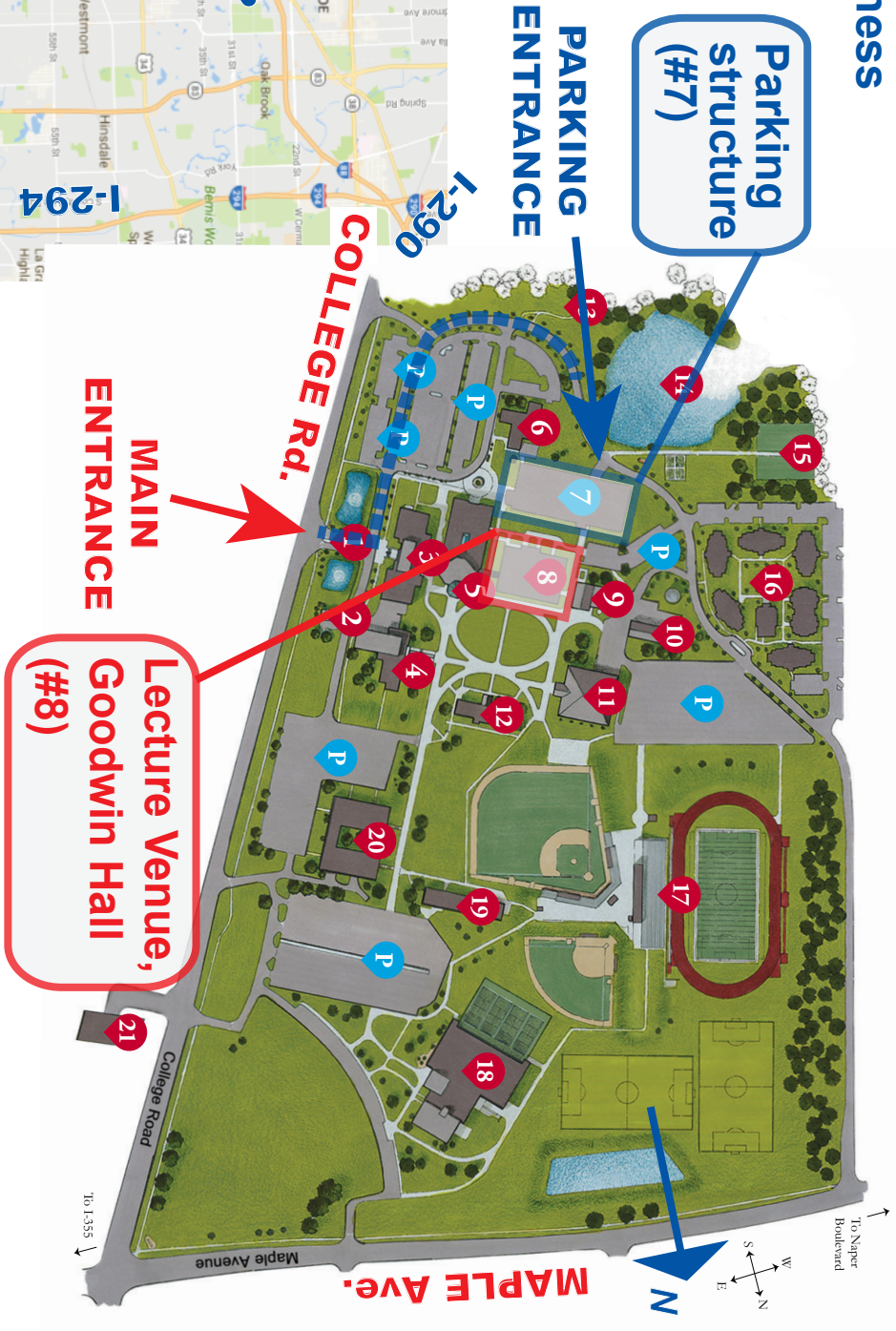
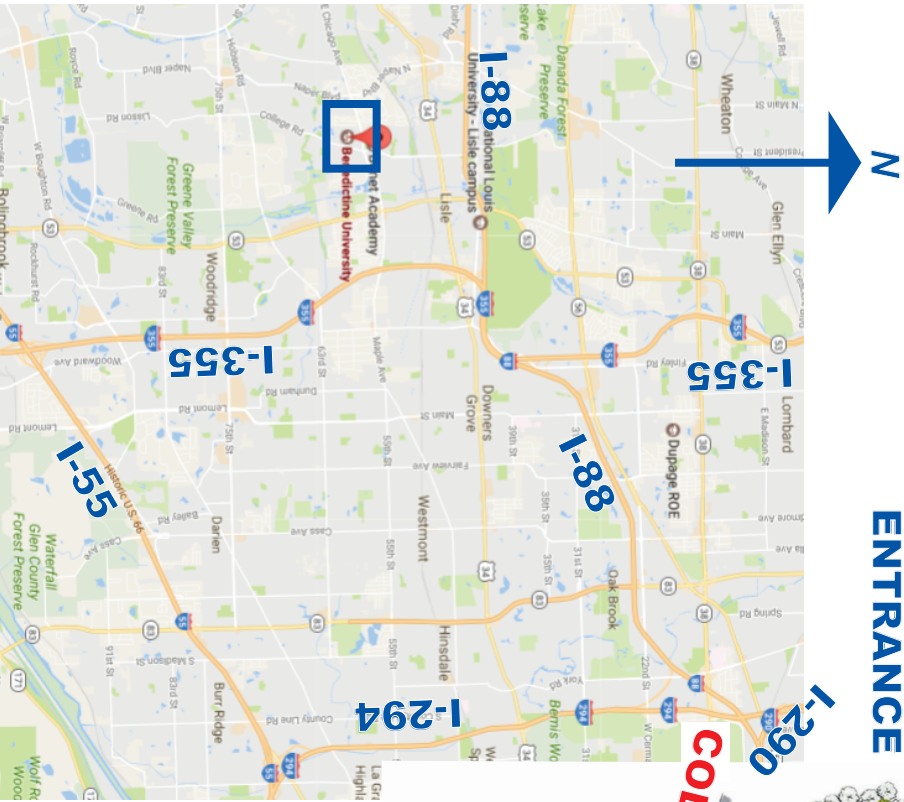

DIRECTIONS TO BENEDICTINE COLLEGE:

From the North (Abbott Park, e.g.):

Take I-94 E (Southward), merge with I-294 S. Merge with I-88 W (toward Aurora), then merge with I-355 S (toward Joliet). Proceed 3.3 miles in I-355 S and exit at Maple Ave. Turn right on Maple and proceed 2.1 miles west. At College Rd., turn left and proceed a few hundred feet to Benedictine's main entrance. Enter the campus, turn left, and proceed to the parking structure as the road veers right.

From the South & Indiana (Indiana, Tinley Park, e.g.):

Take I-80 W, then merge with I-355 N (toward W Suburbs). Proceed approx. 16 miles on I-355 N and exit at Maple Ave. Turn left on Maple and proceed 2.1 miles west. At College Rd., turn left and proceed a few hundred feet to Benedictine's main entrance. Enter the campus, turn left, and proceed to the parking structure as the road veers right.

From the Northwest (Schaumburg, e.g.):

Take I-290 S, merge onto I-355 S. Proceed south on I-355 S and exit at Maple Ave. Turn right on Maple and proceed 2.1 miles west. At College Rd., turn left and proceed a few hundred feet to Benedictine's main entrance. Enter the campus, turn left, and proceed to the parking structure as the road veers right.

From downtown Chicago (UIC, e.g.)

Take I-290 W, merge onto I-88 W, then merge onto I-355 S. Proceed 3.3 miles in I-355 S and exit at Maple Ave. Turn right on Maple and proceed 2.1 miles west. At College Rd., turn left and proceed a few hundred feet to Benedictine's main entrance. Enter the campus, turn left, and proceed to the parking structure as the road veers right.

Parking: Free in parking structure

Bus: Benedictine does appear to be served by bus routes enabling access to evening events. See <http://www.pacebus.com>

Metra: The Lisle Metra station, served by the BNSF route (<https://metrarail.com/maps-schedules/train-lines/BNSF>) is approximately two miles from Benedictine. No buses run between the Metra station and the university in the evening.
