



What is the Crisp Packet Project?

The Crisp Packet project uses empty foil crisp packets and foil chocolate wrappers to create Bivi sleeping bag and survival sheets for those living on the streets.

A crisp packet can take 80 years to decompose. Turning them into something useful reduces waste and provides comfort to those in need. Each blanket uses 44 packets. That's 3520 recycling years!
