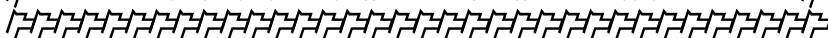

NOTE:

MB-F accepts entries for AKC events in accordance with the latest Agreement, entry form instructions and Rules Applying to Dog Shows (rules) of the American Kennel Club. From time to time these are subject to change. In the event of a discrepancy in these entry form instructions, Agreement and rules versus the text within the entry form you sign and submit, the AKC Agreement, entry form instructions and rules in effect at the time these entries close will take precedence.

Special Message to Exhibitors & Handlers

Extreme Weather Conditions or CDC, State, Federal or Showsite Guidelines may cause the Event Committees to cancel and or modify the requirements at these events at any time. This is to ensure the health and safety of our dogs, judges and fanciers.

The following breeds must be judged on a ramp through all levels of conformation competition: Clumber Spaniels, Sussex Spaniels, Basset Hounds, Cirnechi dell'Etna, Kerry Blue Terriers, Bulldogs, Chinese Shar-Pei, Chow Chows & Keeshonden. Breeds designated as ramp optional may, at the discretion of the judge, be judged on a ramp through all levels of competition. Judges may request the ramp to judge any breed in emergency situations; if granted, unless the use of a ramp has been indicated in the premium list, an exhibitor has the option of withdrawing their entry and receiving a refund. Junior Showmanship judges should follow the above.

Photography Notice

Only pre-contracted photographers, contracted vendors and the press may take photos for commercial use. If you are a commercial photographer and you have a pre-existing contract with a client, only photos of that client may be taken. You may not freelance and post photos for sale of dogs and/or handlers without a pre-existing contract. NO exceptions!

Private photos, not for resale, may be taken.

This rule is in place out of fairness to the contracted photographers and vendors who have gone through the normal process to be part of these shows.

Thank you for adhering to this policy.

AKC BOARD POLICY MANUAL

Grooming Space (July 2012 Board meeting; amended December 2015)

It is the policy of the AKC to encourage and welcome all exhibitors. Keeping the cost of participating in the Sport reasonable for current as well as potential new competitors is crucial to its future health and growth. At the same time, the Board recognizes the financial pressure faced by many clubs in putting on their events. The Board has therefore established the following policy, effective January 1, 2013, with regard to grooming space:

All clubs are required to set aside an area designated for grooming/crating. "Day of Event" grooming must be provided that is reasonable in relation to entry of the show. A club holding a conformation event may, at its option, offer reserved grooming/crating space for a fee, provided that it makes available, at no charge in addition to the entry fee for the show, a reasonable amount of grooming/crating space of equal desirability to the exhibitors. Such free space need not include additional services such as the availability of electrical hookups.



In keeping with AKC Policy, and to provide for the comfort and safety of both exhibitors and dogs, the Virginia Spring Fling Cluster will have crating/grooming areas as outlined below.

DAY OF EVENT CRATING/GROOMING. FREE. NO ELECTRIC. Limited space. Show committee may direct placement of equipment, may require that crates be stacked and may limit chairs in Day of Event Crating/Grooming. All equipment must be removed at the end of each day's show.

OPEN GROOMING. FREE. NO ELECTRIC. Limited space with predetermined layout of aisles and crates. Show committee may require that crates be stacked. Equipment may remain in the building overnight Wednesday - Saturday nights but must be removed one hour after BIS Sunday. Dogs in Open Grooming may NOT remain overnight.

PRIME (RESERVED) GROOMING. FEES INCLUDE ELECTRIC. Limited space. See page 10 for sizes, fee information and reservation form. Equipment may remain in the building overnight Wednesday - Saturday nights but must be removed one hour after BIS Sunday. Dogs in Reserved Grooming **MAY** remain overnight with crate tags and signed release form.

Notice to Exhibitors

Vehicle lights must be left on while loading and unloading.

With the exception of Handicapped and official club business, motorized scooters will not be allowed in the building.

The kennel clubs are not responsible for the actions or products of the commercial vendors at these events.

We highly recommend that you do not leave dogs unattended in cars, exercise pens or motor homes; and we suggest that you secure your crates for the safety of your dogs.

No retractable/flexible leads allowed in the building.

NO SAVING OF PARKING SPACES, EXCEPT FOR PAID RESERVED PRIME PARKING.

Handlers & Exhibitors will be responsible for the actions of their dogs and maintaining control of their dogs.

Bathing Stations will be available outside.

For the safety of all participants and dogs, children must be under the direct control and supervision of their parents at all times. Adults who fail to properly supervise children under their care may be subject to Event Committee Hearing. Baby strollers are not allowed in the building. 4-Wheeled wagon-type carts used to transport children are not permitted in the building unless they are completely enclosed.

THE CLUSTER RESERVES THE RIGHT TO REMOVE ANY ANIMAL IN DISTRESS FROM A PARKED VEHICLE OR CRATE, AND ALL PERSONS ATTENDING THESE DOG EVENTS HEREBY WAIVE ANY CLAIM FOR DAMAGES AGAINST THE CLUBS FOR SUCH REMOVAL.

All Dogs must be removed no later than one hour after Best in Show on Sunday. Equipment may remain in the building, but may be shifted to allow for cleaning.

Building will open at approximately 3:00 P.M. Wednesday for general exhibitors, OR when set up is completed, at the discretion of the Cluster Committee. Vendors and show personnel may set up earlier at the discretion of the Cluster Committee.

Doors locked from 10:00 P.M. to 6:00 A.M.

Parking Fee: \$5.00 per car per day, \$15.00 for 4 day pass.

Crate identification labels and contact numbers are recommended for all crates and are required for dogs in building overnight.

Ample trash cans & bins will be available in the show areas. Please help us keep the show grounds clean. Exhibitors & handlers will be responsible for clean conditions in and around their crates & vehicles.

NO SPACE FOR UNENTERED DOGS. NO OVERNIGHT CRATED DOGS EXCEPT THOSE IN RESERVED GROOMING SPACE WITH SIGNED RELEASE FORM.

NO PRIVATE X-PENS INSIDE. NO SOFT SIDED CRATES.

RINGSIDE OR AISLE CRATING LIMITED TO 15 MINUTES PRIOR TO SCHEDULED RING TIME.

CRATES AND OTHER ITEMS MUST BE REMOVED IMMEDIATELY AFTER COMPETITION OF BREED AND/OR GROUP JUDGING. NO SCISSORING OR SPRAYING OF PRODUCT PERMITTED RINGSIDE.

ABSOLUTELY NO SHAVINGS IN PRIVATE X-PENS OUTSIDE OR ON GROUNDS WITHOUT SITE CONTROL APPROVAL.

\$35.00 SERVICE CHARGE ON NON SUFFICIENT FUNDS RETURNED CHECKS.

No gasoline or diesel generators are permitted inside any building.

Overnight RV Parking is \$60.00 per night per space. Reservations are available on a first come, first served basis.

RVs may arrive on the grounds to park after **12:00 Noon Wednesday, March 20, 2024**. The fee is **\$60.00 per night** per space. Priority is given to reservations for five nights - Wednesday through Sunday. RV parking will be in assigned spaces and only one vehicle permitted per space. A tow unit with a trailer is considered one vehicle. All units must be self-contained. No waste or gray water may be discharged onto the grounds. Confirmation will only be sent if a self-addressed stamped envelope is included with the reservation request. This confirmation will include a reference number which will help parking personnel direct you to your RV space quickly. Please include a "self-addressed stamped envelope" for confirmation of reservation. If you wish to park next to a particular party, the reservation applications must be received in the same envelope. No cones or other means of saving space will be allowed unless directed by Site Control personnel. Overnight parking is a privilege extended by the Meadow Event Park and the Cluster Clubs. No abusive or argumentative language will be permitted. Failure to follow the rules or direction of the Officials on duty will cause the immediate forfeiture of all parking privileges without refund of fees paid. AKC National Owner-Handled Series

(Remember to check the box near the bottom of the entry form)

The AKC National Owner-Handled Series is a non-titling competition for dogs that are exhibited by their owners that are not professional handlers.

Exhibitors must declare their dog is Owner-Handled eligible at the time of entry on the entry form.

Dogs entered in the Amateur-Owner-Handler class will automatically be marked as eligible to compete in the NOHS.

Eligible dogs will be identified by an asterisk in the judge's book, steward's book and the catalog. Dogs must be handled throughout the breed level competition for the regular show by an eligible owner.

Professional handlers*, household members and current assistants** to professional handlers may not exhibit the dog in any NOHS competition during the entire show. For a detailed description of the National Owner-Handled Series, please visit the AKC website NOHS pages at:

**Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years.*

***A current assistant is defined as anyone employed by a professional handler on a full-time basis or assisting a professional handler at the show or any time during the cluster/weekend. Current assistants that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age & amateur status requirements) may participate in NOHS.*

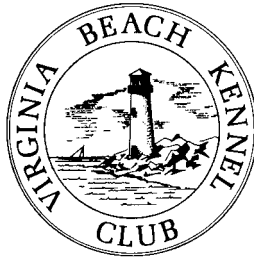

Attention Owners/Exhibitors of Foreign Registered Dogs

If you are the owner/exhibitor of a dog registered with a foreign registry (not yet dual registered with AKC) please review the eligibility requirements in The Rules Applying to Dog Shows, chapter 11 section 1.

The dog show rules are posted on the AKC Web site at: <http://images.akc.org/pdf/rulebooks/RREGS3.pdf>

Most important to note are the following:

1. Dogs must be individually registered with the American Kennel Club by the day of the event to be eligible for exhibit in the Bred by Exhibitor class.
