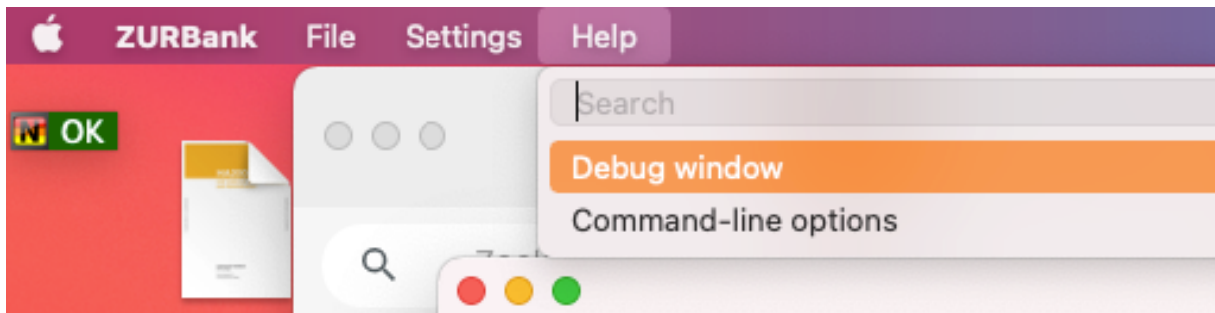
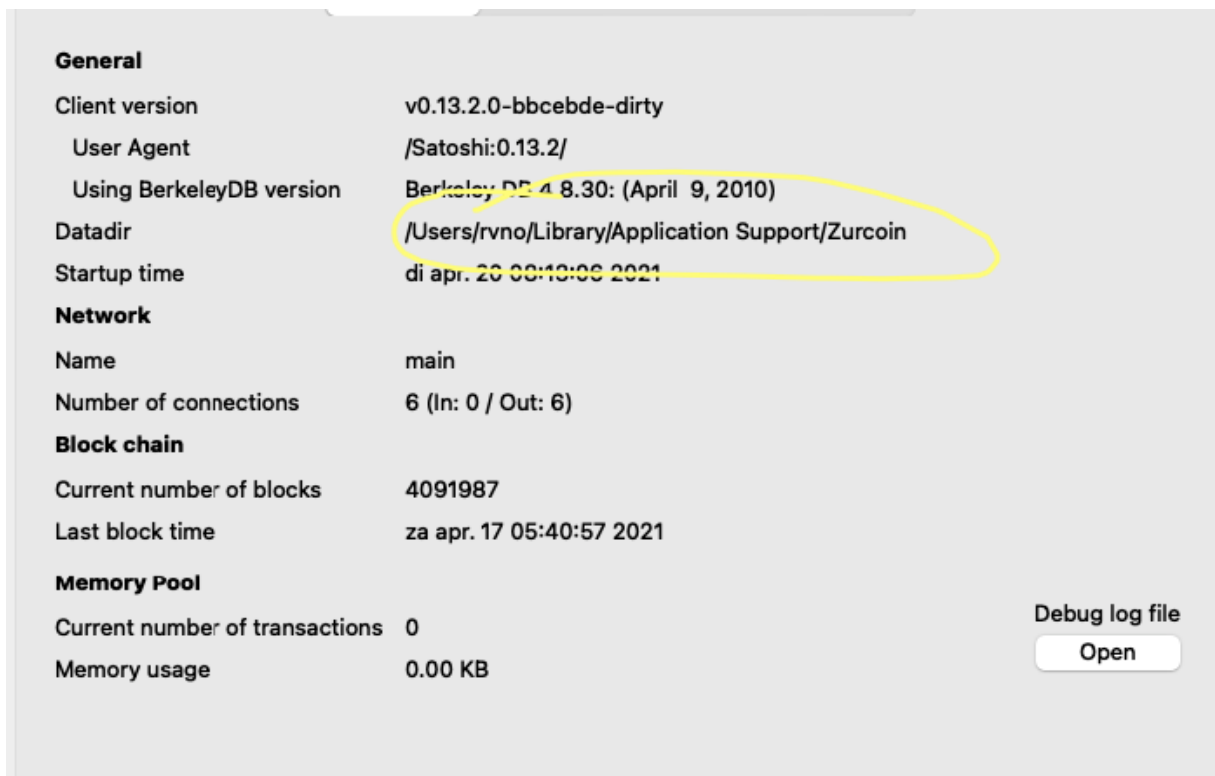


Ok. Make sure you have your old wallet.dat file (you did back him up huh?)

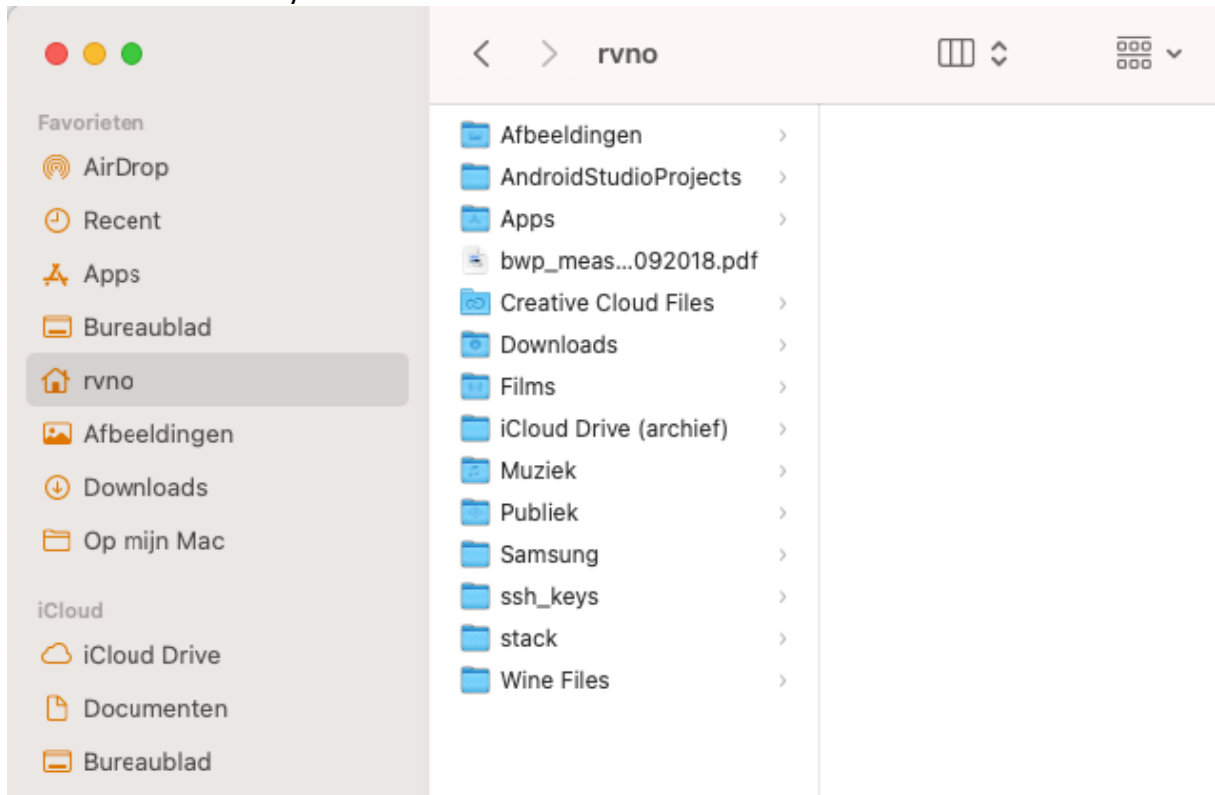
Open your Zurbank wallet and go to help – debug window:



In the screen that pops up next.. you can see where your working dir resides:



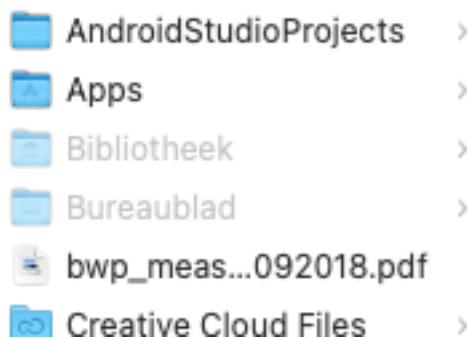
Go to the folder with your finder...



you notice the folder you need isn't there.. it is hidden. You can show hidden files... do this:

click once in the window so you know it's active.. and press:

command+shift . (press command and shift and a dot)  
and the hidden files appear:



"Bibliotheek" is Library

then you can go to the Application support folder, then Zurcoin

there is your wallet.dat. I would backup the old wallet.dat that's in there (rename it to .old or something) and simply copy your wallet.dat file to there. Restart the Zurbank qt app and after full resync your holdings will appear.
