How to Prepare for your appointment & what to expect

How to prepare your space/room for the refinishing appointment:

For us to refinish your surface, we need a clean and clear space to move around, place our tools and set up machines to do our job properly in this room/space. We may be doing work in your bathroom, kitchen, garage, powder room, utility room or even in your backyard. There needs to be running water and electricity for us to work. We need access to a window or door in another room to set up the ventilation/exhaust system.

If you have pets, young children, elderly family members in your home and are sensitive to smells in general, please plan for them to be out of the home while we are working. We use an exhaust system while we are working, and it works to exhaust fumes and dust out of the house. We use low voc products standard to state laws. There will be loud noise and running machinery while we are working and refinishing.

BATHROOM PREP: Please remove the following items from your bathroom. Shower Rods & Shower Curtains, Towels, robes, carpets, rugs. Any bottles of shampoos, soaps, shower caddies, luffas, razors. All items from the vanity countertop around the sink, toothbrushes, face wash, combs, soaps, candles, etc. Please remove any pictures or wall decorations from the bathroom. We can remove the shower doors if necessary.

If you will be replacing any fixtures such as drains, overflow, faucets, please have those items removed for us to do the work. Once the tub is dry you can reinstall the fixtures.

For full bathroom refinish, please have toilet and vanity sink removed. Those can be reinstalled after the refinish is dry.

Items, such as shelves, mirrors or other fixtures that cannot be removed, will be covered, and protected against any overspray.

If you are unable to remove any items yourself, we will happily do them for you.

KITCHEN PREP: If we are refinishing a kitchen sink, countertops, or floors, please remove all items completely from the kitchen. Countertops should be bare. Cabinets should be wiped down. The sink should be clear of any items or dishes, soap dispensers, etc. The kitchen floor should have all the carpets removed.

If you have pets, please clean, dust and wipe down the floors, walls, and areas around the room to limit the amount of pet hair and dust circulating in the air during the refinishing process. This will give your refinished surface the best chance of being dust free.
