Sauvignon Blanc, Leyda Classic Coastal Chile, 2017 ~ Dry, herbal and citrus notes along with tropical notes of guava and passion fruit. C 9 28.50

Sauvignon Blanc, Drylands New Zealand 2016 ~ Layers of passion fruit and pink grapefruit with hints of tropical fruit, melon and fresh herbs. Rich mouth feel with impressive structure of juicy acidity as expected from NZ. C 30

Chardonnay ~ Sean Minor 4 Bears Central Coast CA 2018 ~ Aromas of pears, apples and tropical nuances with subtle notes of butter 9.75 29 Special 7.00 glass 24 bottle

Chardonnay, Butter Acampo, CA 2016 ~ Rich and bold, cold fermented to a lush creaminess. Aged in a unique blend of oak. Flavors of stone fruit and baked lemon notes. Lovely, long, vanilla finish. J 11 32

Chardonnay ~ Sean Minor Sonoma Coast 2018 ~ elegant chardonnay charms wine lovers with flavors of baked green apple, lemon curd and warm pineapple finishing with hints of cardamom and vanilla. H 39

Chardonnay, Duckhorn Napa Valley 2017 ~ Alluring aromas of nectarine, yellow plum and pineapple upside down cake. The French Oak aging inspires hints of vanilla and clove. C 60

Moscato, 7 Daughters Italy ~ Bright, fruity aromas of golden raisin and apricot with a crisp, fruity sweet, medium body and tangy honey pear citrus finish. A tasty, sweet sipper. C 7.25 23

Angelina, Rosé of Pinot Noir California 2017 ~ delicious aromas of watermelon, nectarine, and ruby red grapefruit, complimented by floral notes. Clean finish. H 9 25

Gérard Bertrand, Cote des Rosés Languedoc region of France 2016 ~ Embodies the Mediterranean Art de Vivre. Fresh and fruity, best at 50 degrees. J 38.50

Pinot Noir, Lyric CA 2016 ~ Fresh Bing cherry, raspberry and hints of kola nut. Bright palate which offers tart pomegranate and hibiscus flavors. Silky and elegant. J **12 36**

Pinot Noir, Luli CA 2016 ~ Vibrant aromatics of black cherry and ripe strawberry. Showcases the rugged, foggy slopes of the Santa Lucia Highlands. Lively acidity and rich flavors of crushed plum and baking spice. H **48**

Cabernet, Alexander Brown Uncaged CA 2016 ~ Aromas of black cherry and mocha. Mid palate layers of blackberry, black currant, chocolate and subtle spice flavors. Smooth, balanced, elegant, long, lingering finish. L **10 31**

Cabernet, Josh Cellars CA 2016 ~ Ripe blackberry and cherry flavors, accented by spices and toasted oak. Expressive and bold while being smooth and approachable. Long, soft finish. J **9 30.25**

Cabernet, Juggernaut CA 2016 ~ Pure, intense, seamless. This hillside cabs French oak aging transforms intense mountain fruit into a wine uncommonly rich and smooth. Fierce, brave and delicious! J **42**

Cabernet, Cuttings CA 2016 ~ French Oak aged. Aromas of roasted coffee, black currant, vanilla bean, spice and wild berries. On the palate, deliciously smooth flavors of blueberry, black cherry and cocoa. Prisoner Cab! L **82**

Cabernet, Caymus, CA 2015 ~ This vintage continues the family's focus on creating a singular "Caymus" expression of Cabernet, and one they are very proud of. L **160**

Red Blend, Prayers of Sinners, WA 2017 Broody red, deep layers of blackberry, dark fruit, violet and cocoa. L **8 23**

Red Blend, Locations CA-7 Dark ruby red, it bursts with notes of red and black fruits, dried rose petals and a pepper. It evolves into a savory compote of raspberry, kirsch and bitter cherry balanced with mineral and herbal notes. Substantial finish buffered with polished tannins that please the palate. **38.50**

Red Blend, Conundrum, CA 2017 Rich, complex and approachable. Lush flavors of cherries and baking chocolate with fine tannins that create a silky smoothness. From the Wagner family wineries, who also create Caymus C **42**

Red Blend, Caravan by Darioush CA 2014 ~ Ripe and decadent with pleasing notes of plum, raspberry and chocolate. Complex, balanced. Polished tannins complemented by dark, spicy notes of black currant and cinnamon. Cabernet, Merlot, Malbec, Petit Verdot. L **70**

Red Blend, Prisoner CA 2017 ~ Interesting blend of Zinfandel with the unlikely mix of Cabernet, Petite Syrah, Syrah, and Italian Charbono grapes. Enticing aroma of cherry, dark chocolate, clove, and roasted fig. L **84**

Red Blend, Orin Swift Machete CA 2015 ~ A brooding hue and viscous consistency, powerful aromas of crème de cassis, boysenberry and ripe cherries complemented by a soft minerality and hints of dark chocolate. J **122**

Red Blend, Orin Swift '8 years in the desert' CA 2017 ~ Heady aromas of raspberry, black fig and peppercorn dominate. Time in the glass exposes dark chocolate and fennel. Lush palate flavors of blackberry, dark plum and currents. Top 1% of all wines in the world. J **118**

Malbec, La Posta Argentina 2017 ~ Cherry, raspberry and violet aromas, spice notes and soft caramel finish. L **30**

Merlot, Charles Krug CA 2017 ~ aromas of ripe red & black fruit followed by hints of spice. Long, smooth finish J **40**

Zinfandel, High Valley ~ CA 2017 Notes of raspberry and blackberry, rich and intense H **36**
