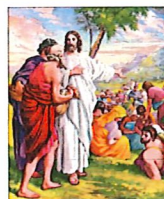

The institution of the Eucharist

1337 The Lord, having loved those who were his own, loved them to the end. Knowing that the hour had come to leave this world and return to the Father, in the course of a meal he washed their feet and gave them the commandment of love. In order to leave them a pledge of this love, in order never to depart from his own and to make them sharers in his Passover, he instituted the Eucharist as the memorial of his death and Resurrection, and commanded his apostles to celebrate it until his return; "thereby he constituted them priests of the New Testament."

1338 The three synoptic Gospels and St. Paul have handed on to us the account of the institution of the Eucharist; St. John, for his part, reports the words of Jesus in the synagogue of Capernaum that prepare for the institution of the Eucharist: Christ calls himself the bread of life, come down from heaven.

Queenship of the Blessed Virgin Mary









Pope Pius XII established this feast in 1954. But the Blessed Virgin Mary's queenship has roots in Scripture. At the Annunciation, Gabriel announced that Mary's Son would receive the throne of David and rule forever. At the Visitation, Elizabeth calls Mary "mother of my Lord." As in all the mysteries of Mary's life, she is closely associated with Jesus: Her queenship is a share in Jesus' kingship. We can also recall that in the Old Testament the mother of the king has great influence in court.

In the fourth century Saint Ephrem called Mary "Lady" and "Queen." Later Church fathers and doctors continued to use the title. Hymns of the 11th to 13th centuries address Mary as queen: "Hail, Holy Queen," "Hail, Queen of Heaven," "Queen of Heaven." The Dominican rosary and the Franciscan crown as well as numerous invocations in Mary's litany celebrate her queenship.

The feast is a logical follow-up to the Assumption, and is now celebrated on the octave day of that feast. In his 1954 encyclical *To the Queen of Heaven*, Pius XII points out that Mary deserves the title because she is Mother of God, because she is closely associated as the New Eve with Jesus' redemptive work, because of her preeminent perfection, and because of her intercessory power.

La institución de la Eucaristía

1337 El Señor, habiendo amado a los suyos, los amó hasta el fin. Sabiendo que había llegado la hora de partir de este mundo para retornar a su Padre, en el transcurso de una cena, les lavó los pies y les dio el mandamiento del amor. Para dejarles una prenda de este amor, para no a lejarse nunca de los suyos y hacerles partícipes de su Pascua, instituyó la Eucaristía como memorial de su muerte y de su resurrección y ordenó a sus apóstoles celebrarlo hasta su retorno, "constituyéndoles entonces sacerdotes del Nuevo Testamento".

1338 Los tres evangelios sinópticos y san Pablo nos han transmitido el relato de la institución de la Eucaristía; por su parte, san Juan relata las palabras de Jesús en la sinagoga de Cafarnaúm, palabras que preparan la institución de la Eucaristía: Cristo se designa a sí mismo como el pan de vida, bajado del cielo.

Reinado de la Santísima Virgen María



El Papa Pío XII estableció esta fiesta en 1954. Pero el reinado de la Santísima Virgen María tiene sus raíces en las Escrituras. En la Anunciación, Gabriel anunció que el Hijo de María recibiría el trono de David y gobernaría para siempre. En la Visitación, Isabel llama a María "madre de mi Señor". Como en todos los misterios de la vida de María, ella está estrechamente asociada con Jesús: su reinado es una participación en el reinado de Jesús. También podemos recordar que en el Antiguo Testamento la madre del rey tiene una gran influencia en la corte.

En el siglo IV, San Efrén llamó a María "Señora" y "Reina". Posteriormente, los padres y médicos de la Iglesia continuaron usando el título. Los himnos de los siglos XI al XIII se dirigen a María como reina: "Ave, Santa Reina", "Ave, Reina del Cielo", "Reina del Cielo". El rosario dominicano y la corona franciscana, así como numerosas invocaciones en la letanía de María, celebran su reinado.

La fiesta es una continuación lógica de la Asunción y ahora se celebra en el día de la octava de esa fiesta.

En su encíclica A la Reina del Cielo de 1954, Pío XII señala que María merece el título porque es Madre de Dios, porque está estrechamente asociada como Nueva Eva a la obra redentora de Jesús, por su perfección preeminente y por su poder intercesor.

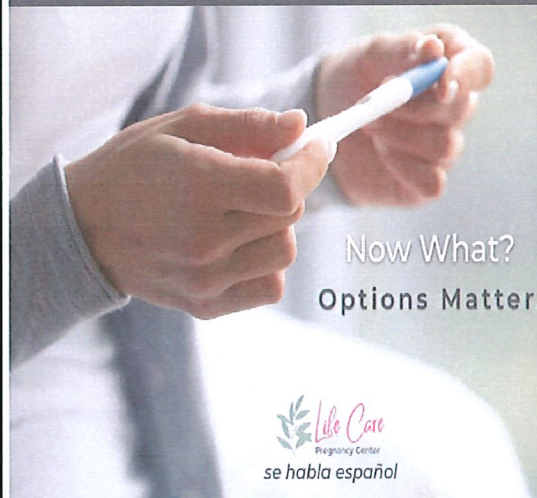
