May I express to the Class of 1960 of the St. Agatha High School my deep appreciation of the invitation to share in the observance of a really notable occasion.

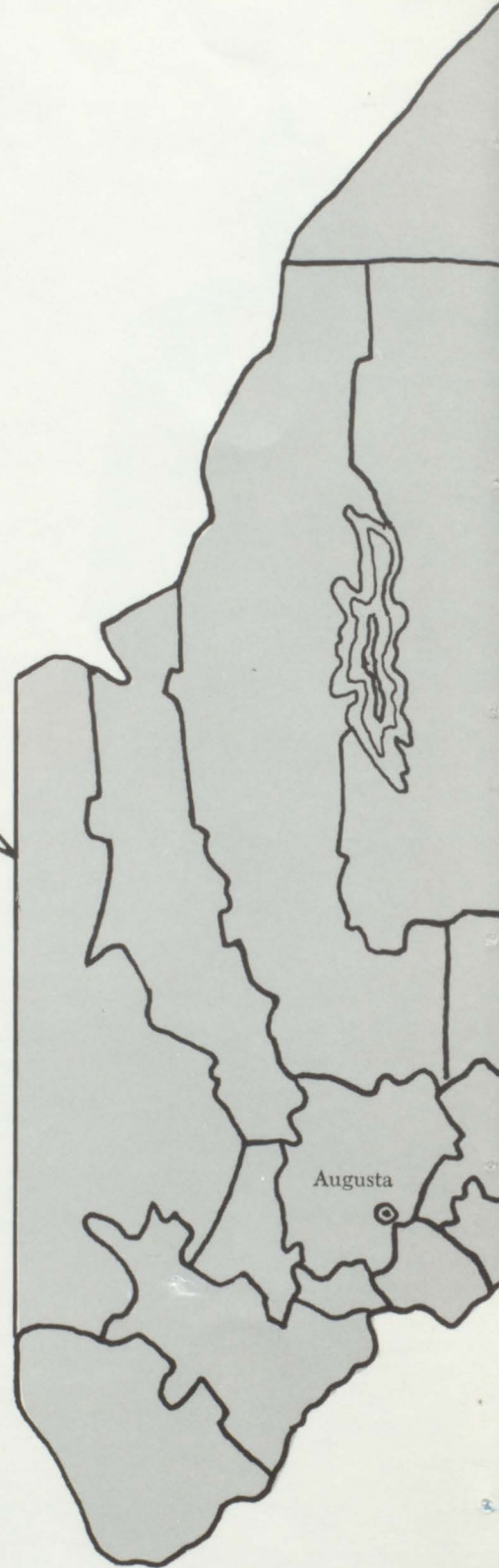



Then, I am happy to join the parents and relatives and friends of the class of 1960 in wishing for the class as a whole and for each one of its members many years of rich and happy service.

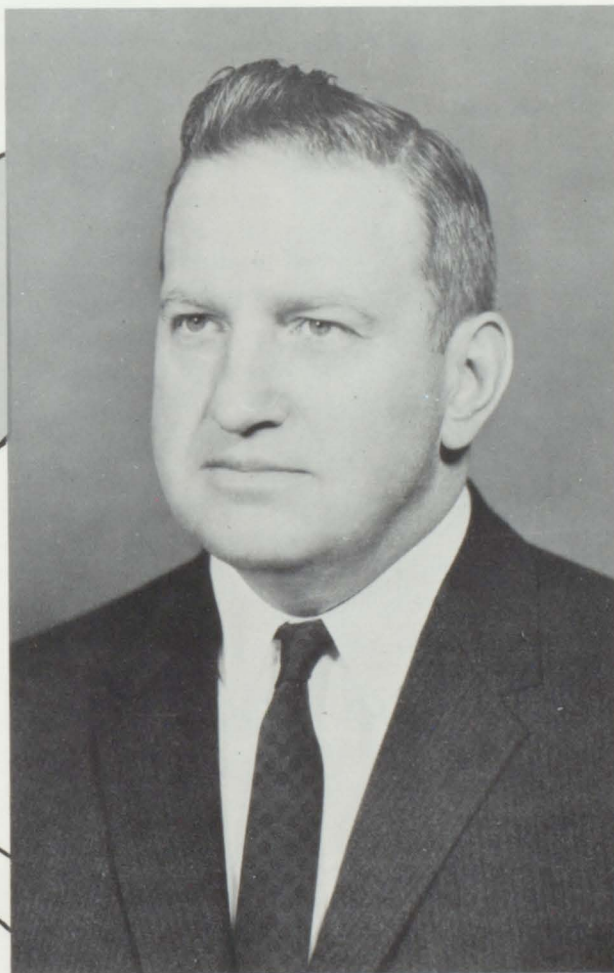

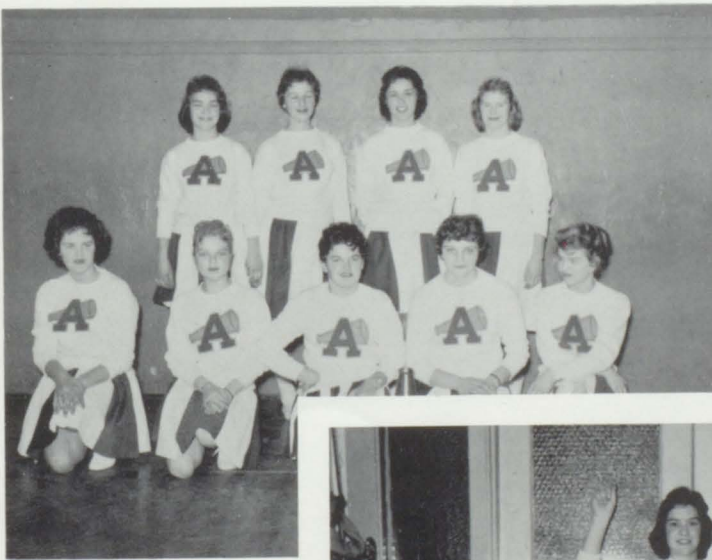
