

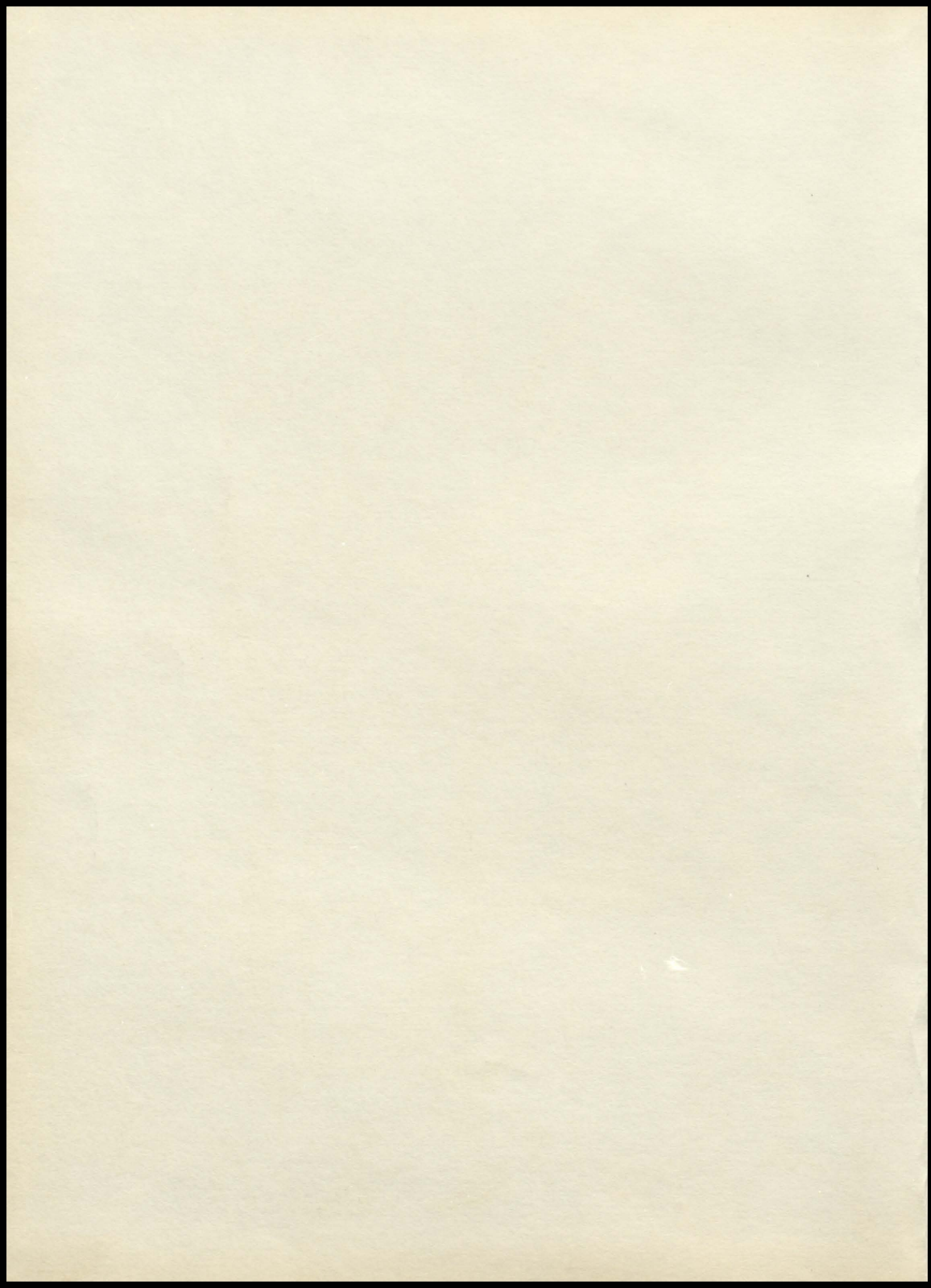

For His constant concern in behalf of humanity, Pope John XXIII has become a symbol of peace and charity.

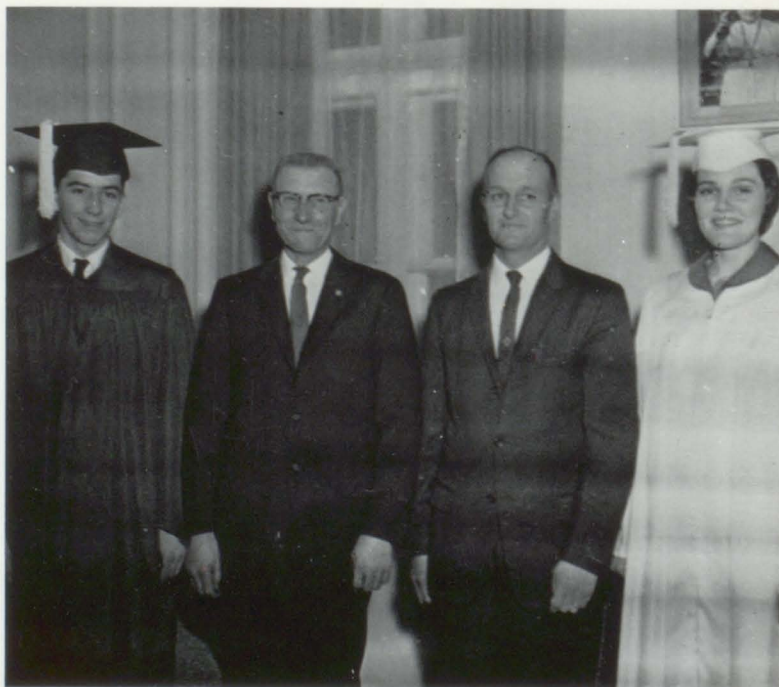

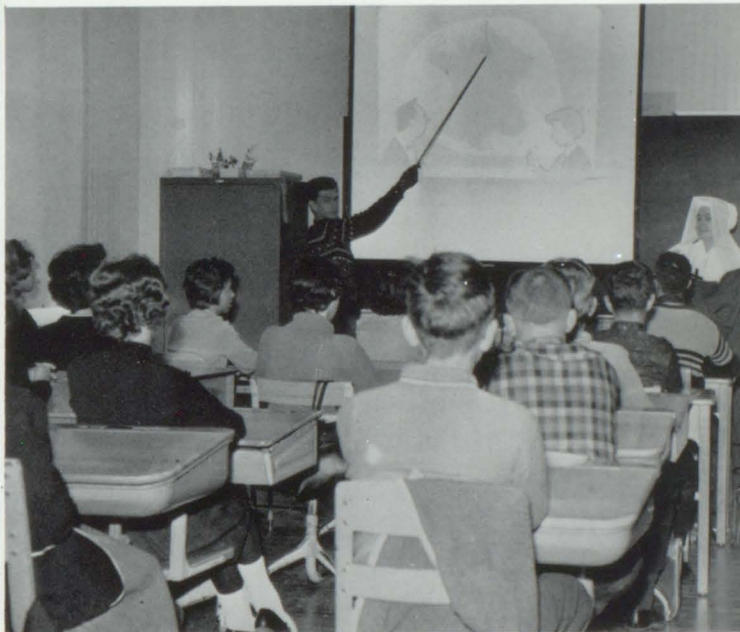

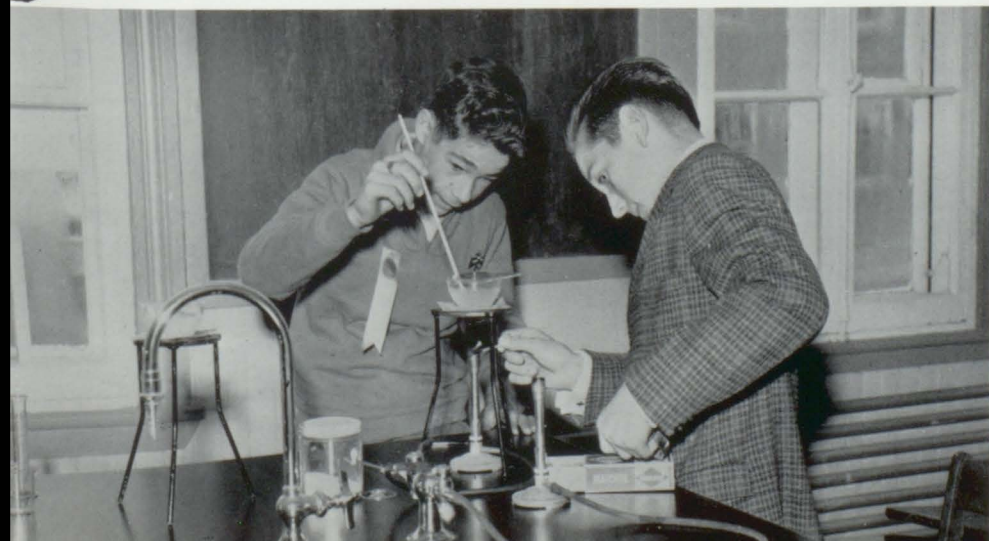

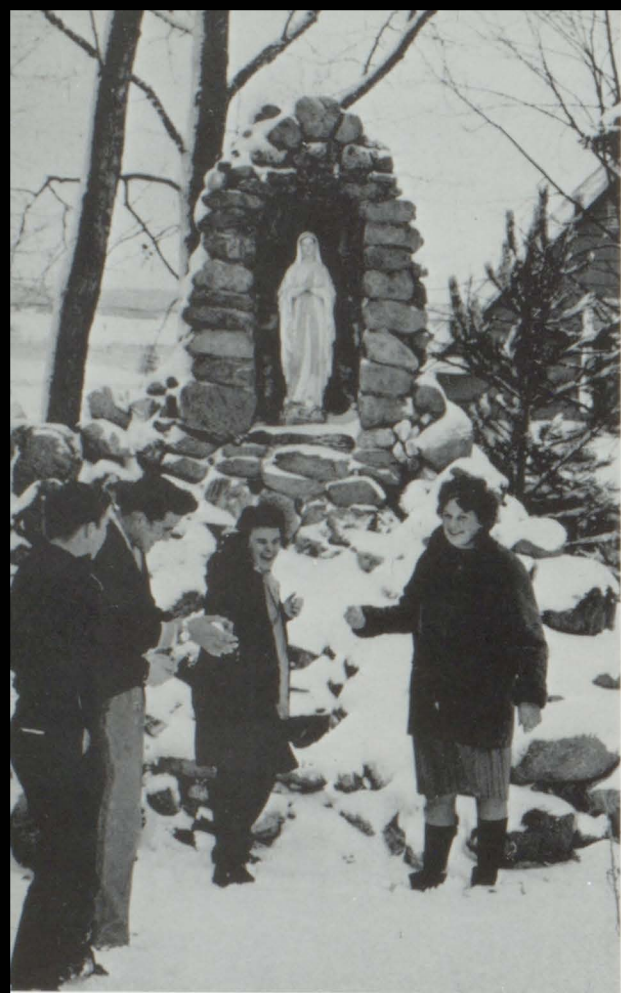

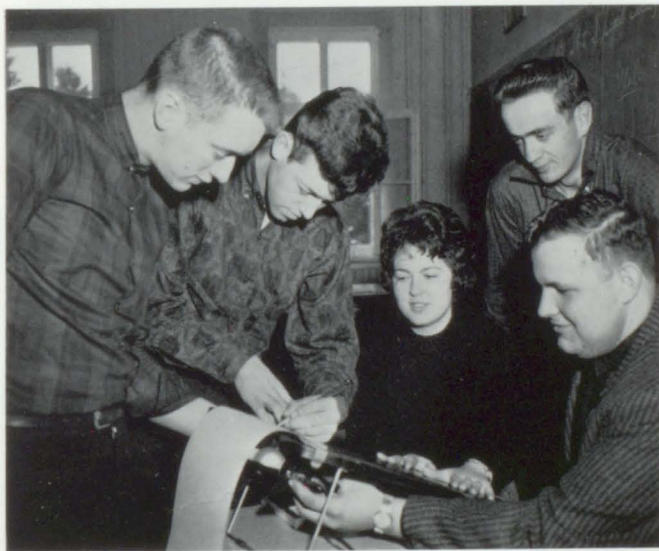

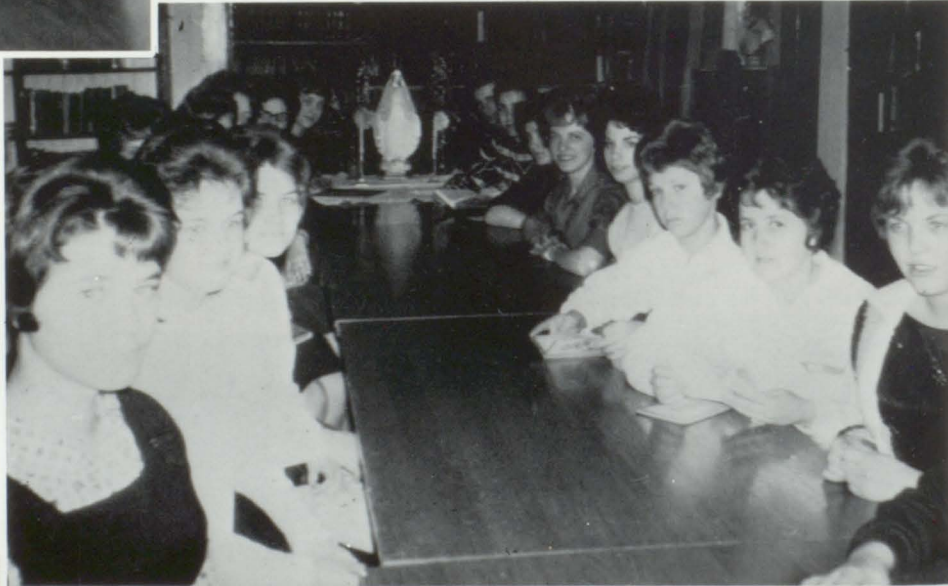

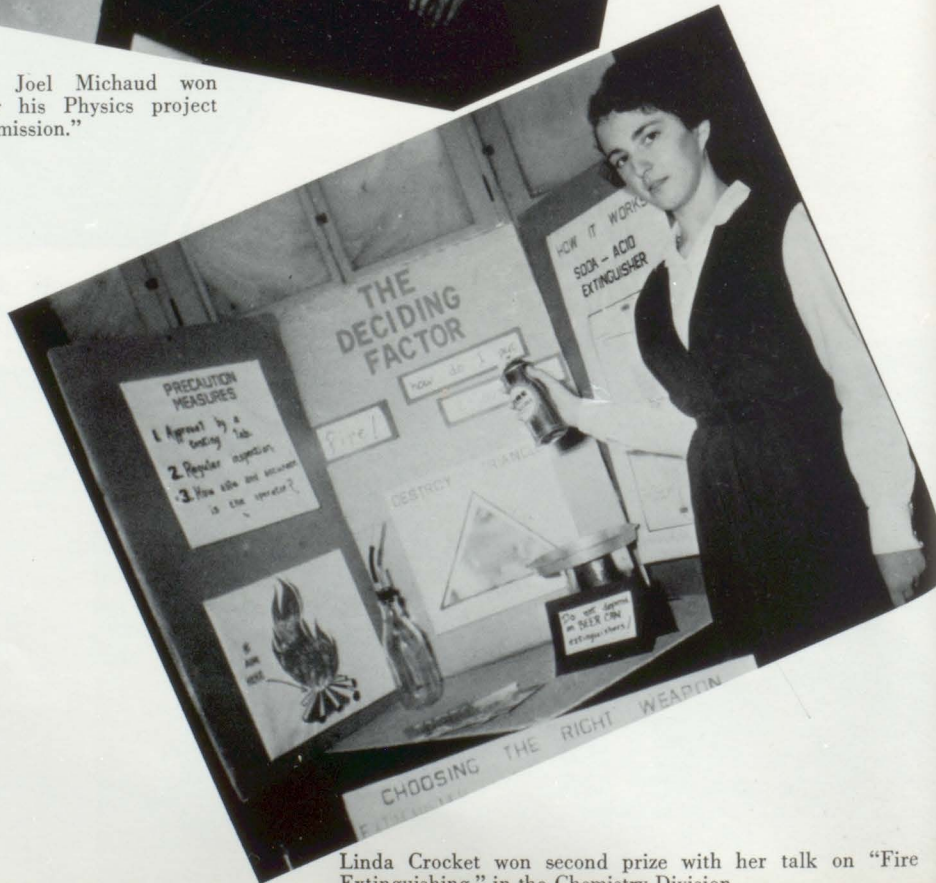
