## GIRL'S VOLLEYBALL

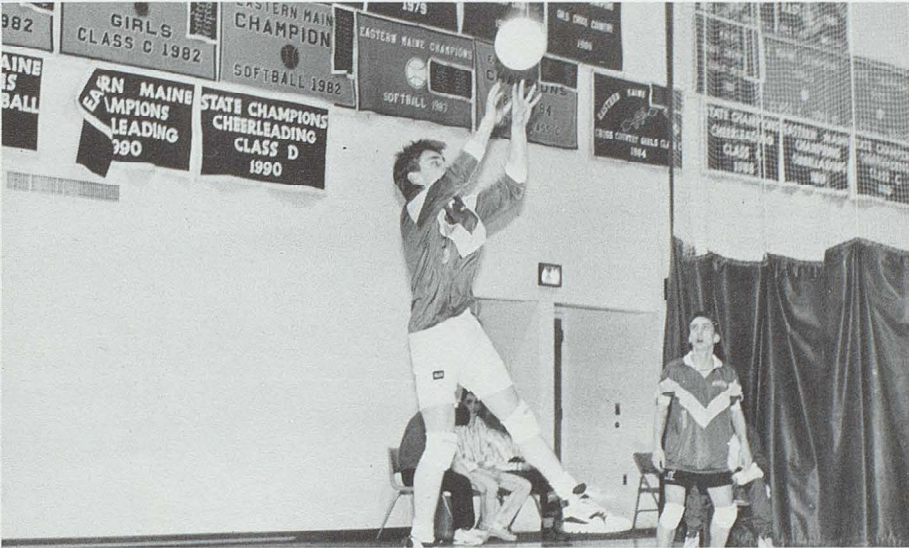

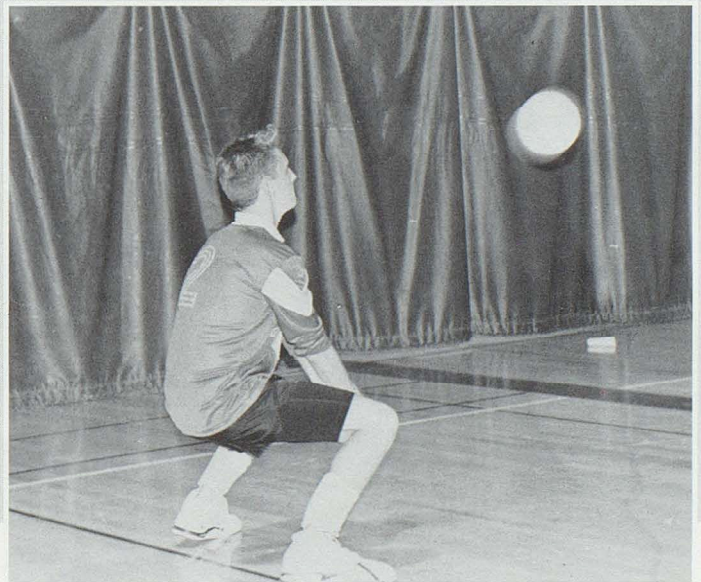
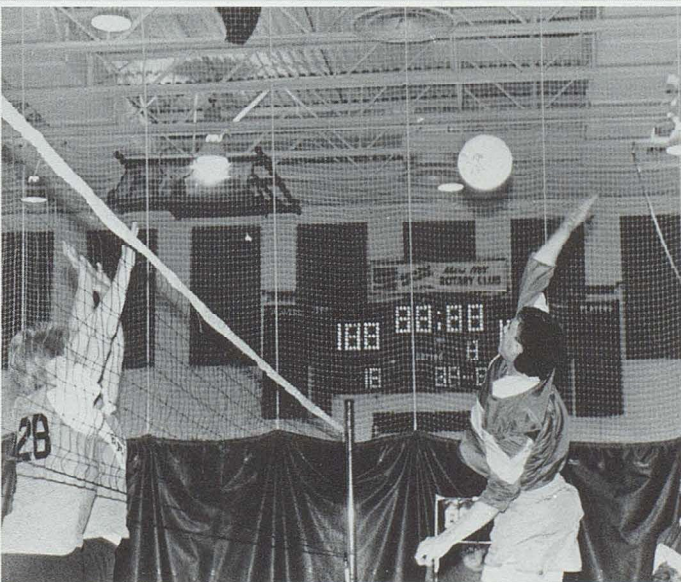






### VOLLEYBALL SUCCESS!

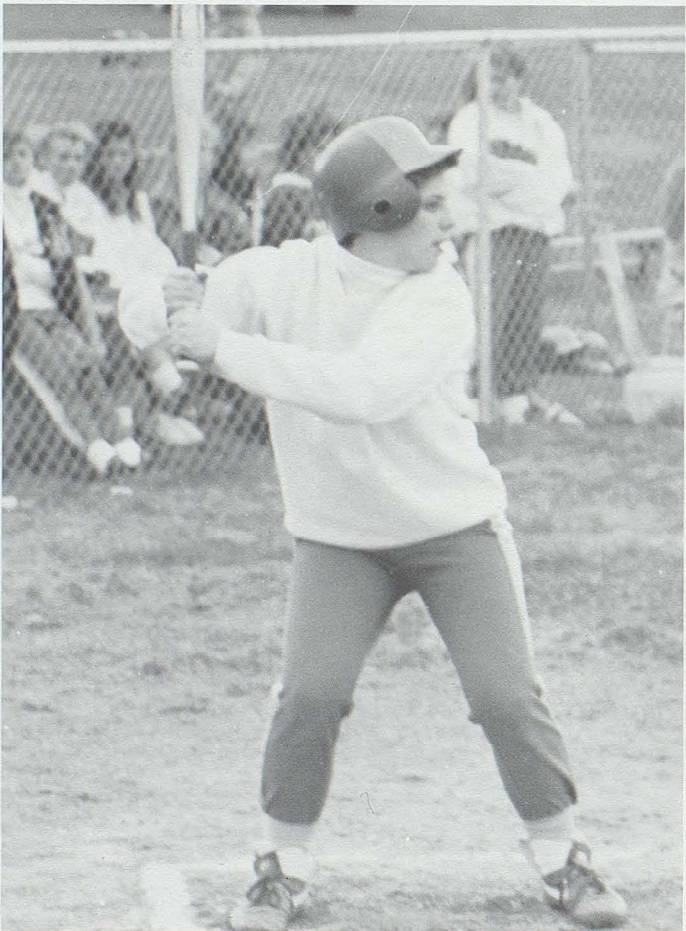
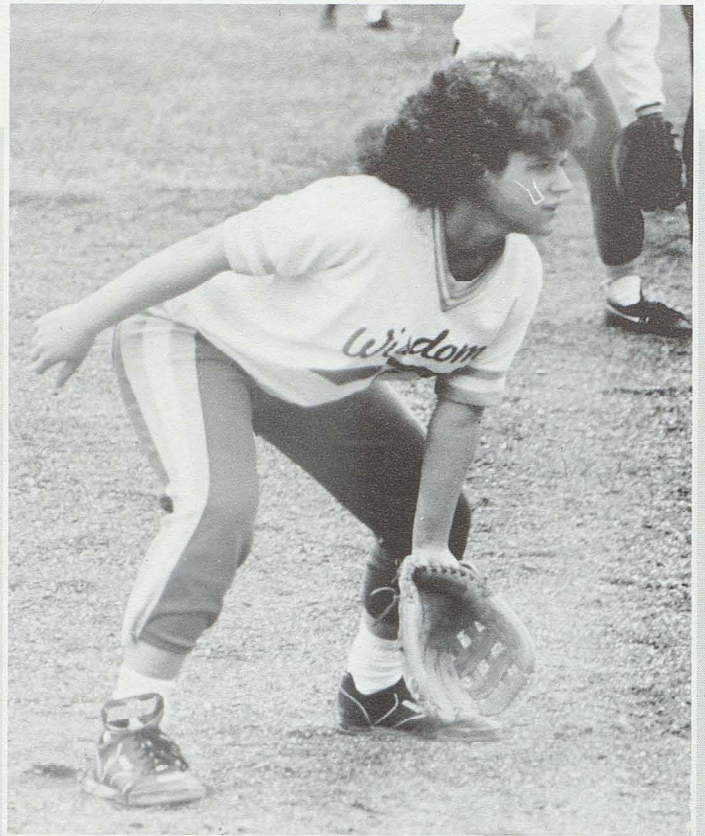

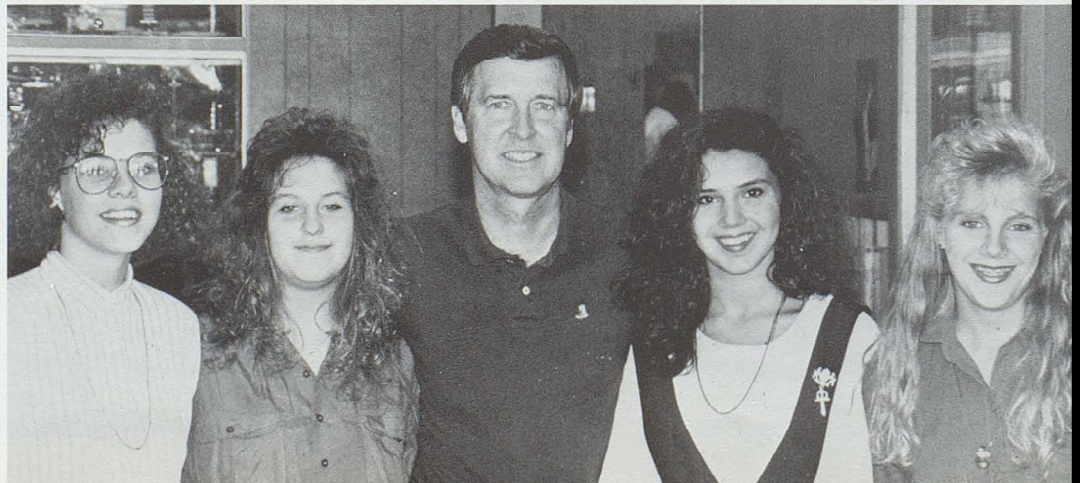
Each story has a special message to deliver so students had to listen and watch very closely as each story unfolded. Everyone had a truly enjoyable time.

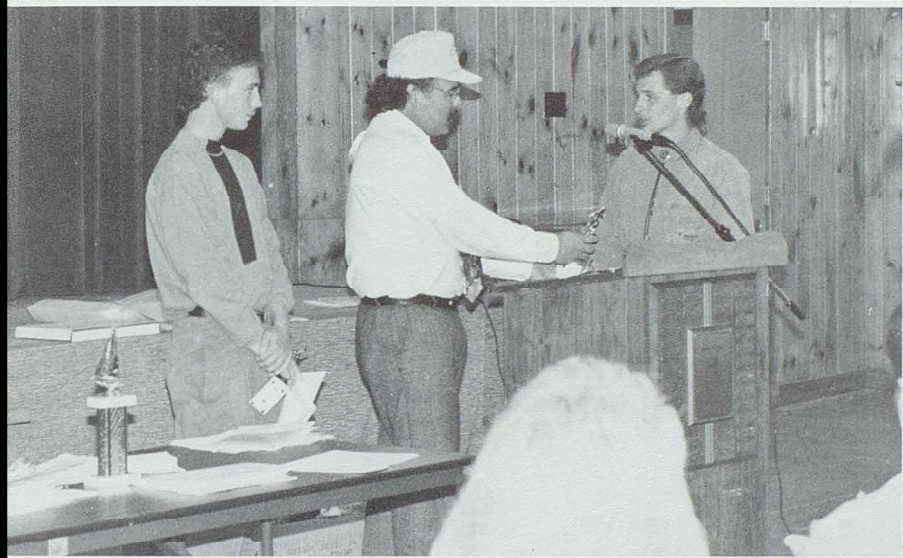

'91

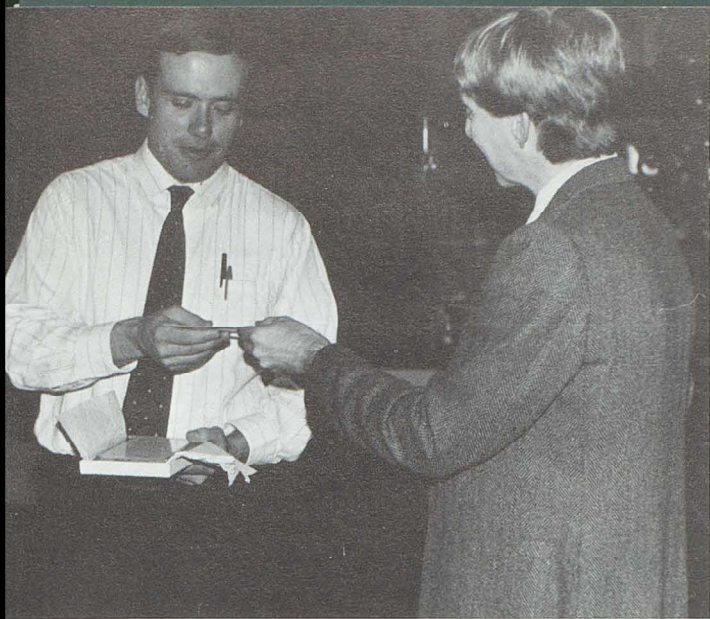
