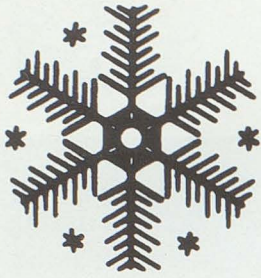

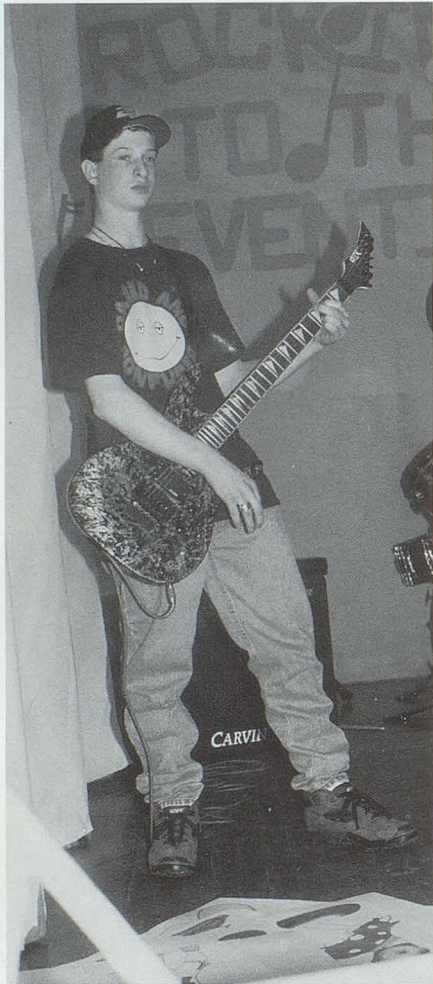
# “Rockin’ In The 70’s”

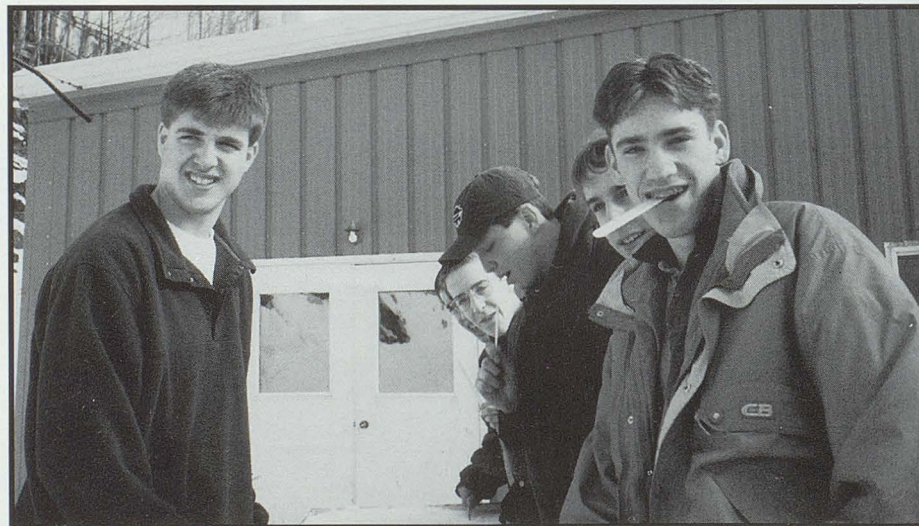

In October, Middle School students elected candidates for Student Council offices. The following were elected:

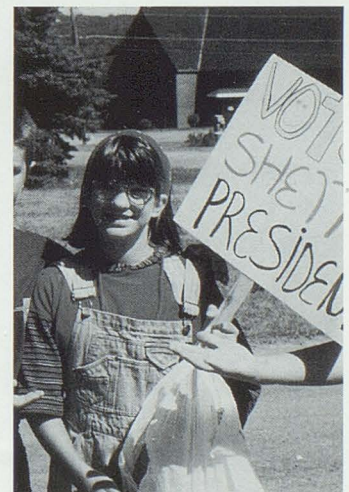
For President, Debra Lowe; Vice-President, Julie Chasse; Secretary, Kelly Cyr; and Treasurer, Courtney Lugdon.
