TYLOR CORRIVEAU

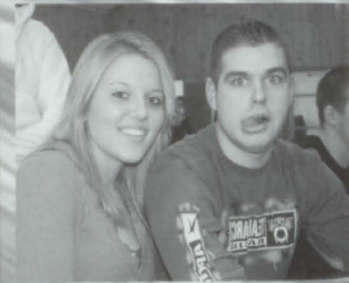
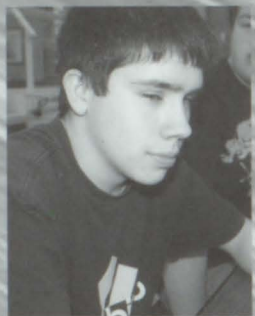


Tylor transferred to Wisdom Middle High School from Nederland High School in Texas, in the second semester of his senior year.

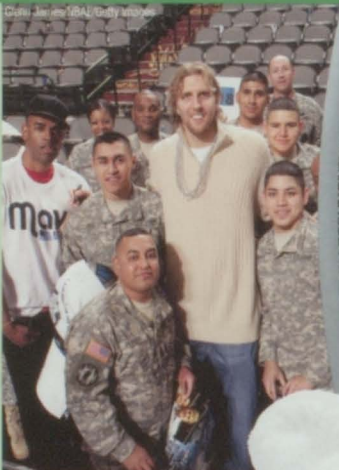

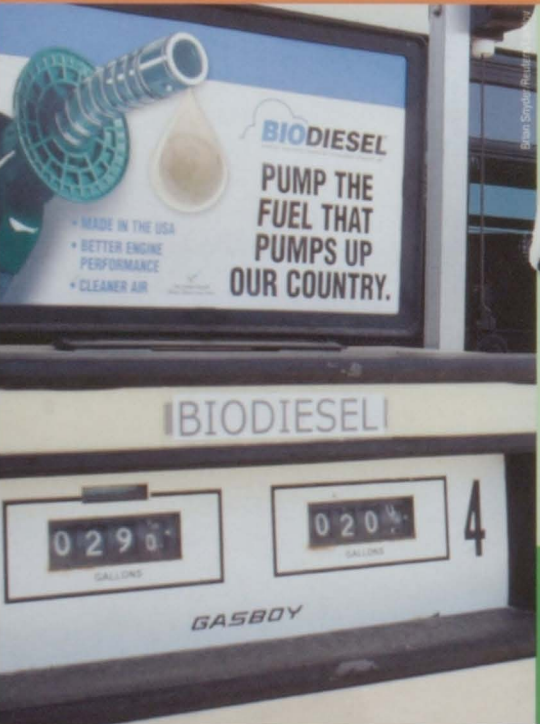

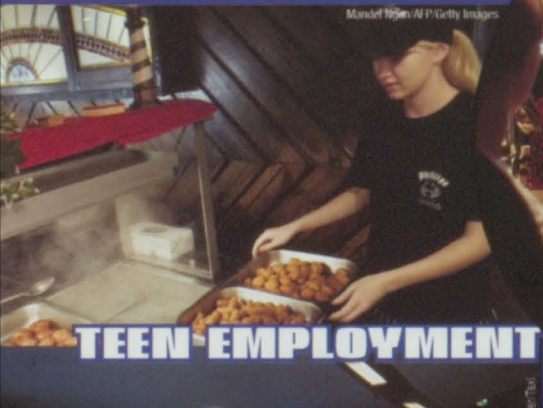
