2023 SUMMER READING PROGRAM! "All Together Now"

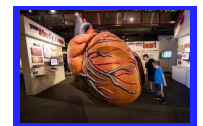

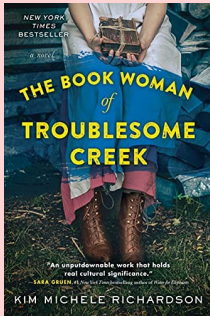

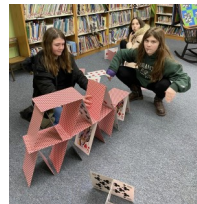
