Emmaus House at New Skete Monastery

Group Retreats and Conferences:

Bring your group to New Skete for a unique and secluded venue. The spacious common areas and the gardens at New Skete's Emmaus House are available for group conferences and workshops. For multi-day retreats we include sleeping rooms with private baths. For overflow we work with a local inn for additional sleeping rooms.

In addition to joining the monks and nuns in daily worship and meals, guests may request an address or series of addresses and meditations from one of the monastics.

10 am - Divine Liturgy

Followed by coffee hour, Monks' Refectory

1 pm - Departure
