

Public comment on items not on the Agenda. Individual members of the public may address the Board for a maximum of three minutes per person on items not on the current agenda (i.e. the public comment section of the meeting). Members of the public may collectively address the Board for a total of thirty minutes on items not on the current agenda (i.e. the public comment section of the meeting). No formal action, discussion, deliberation, or comment will be made for items not on the current agenda.

Public comment on items that are set on the agenda will be limited to a maximum of three minutes per speaker and a maximum of 30 minutes per item pursuant to the District's adopted policy. Speakers will be taken up in the order that they sign up to speak for a particular agenda item. In accordance with the Texas Open Meetings Act, any response to a public comment that is made on an item that is not on the published final agenda will be limited to a statement of factual information or a statement of existing policy given in response to the public comment. Any deliberation or decision by the Board must be limited to a proposal to place the subject on a future agenda.

The Board may retire to Executive Session any time between the meeting's opening and adjournment for the purpose of consulting with legal counsel pursuant to Section 551.071 of the Texas Government Code; discussing real estate acquisition pursuant to Section 551.072 of the Texas Government Code; discussing gifts and donations pursuant to Section 551.073 of the Texas Government Code; discussing personnel matters pursuant to Section 551.074 of the Texas Government Code; discussing security personnel or devices pursuant to Section 551.076 of the Texas Government Code. Action, if any, will be taken in open session.
