## **Building and Grounds Committee**

## **Duties:**

- 1. Oversee the safe-keeping, protection, maintenance and repair of church facilities, furnishing, and attached equipment such as heating, cooling, lighting and storage.
- 2. Make sure that all furnishings and equipment are properly working.
- 3. Make recommendations on replacement of worn items or equipment, landscaping, and care of grounds and parking facilities.
- 4. Make recommendations to the Budget (Finance) Committee as to necessary funds to provide for the annual maintenance of all facilities, furnishings and grounds.
- 5. Take actions in emergency situations regarding church facilities, furnishings and grounds.
- 6. Serve as a resource team when the church considers securing additional or selling property and furnishings.
- 7. Serve as a resource team in facility safety, security and crime prevention issues.
- 8. Conduct annual inventory, inspection and evaluation of all church property and equipment.
- 9. Make recommendations concerning maintenance and usage of church parking facilities and signage.
- 10. Assist and support the church custodial personnel in matters related to the building and grounds.
- \* This committee often is called Maintenance, Property & Space, Facilities Management, or House & Grounds.
