



**NOTICE OF THE ANNUAL MEMBERSHIP MEETING
and SECOND NOTICE OF THE SEAGULL
CONDOMINIUM ASSOCIATION ELECTION OF DIRECTORS**

Under the provisions of Florida Statutes, Chapters 718 & 721, the **Annual Membership Meeting of the Seagull Condominium Association, Inc. will be held after our noon luncheon on Saturday, January 13, 2024, at the Cocoa Beach Country Club located in Cocoa Beach, FL.** The meeting will follow a complimentary buffet luncheon for owners and one guest, which will be served at 12:00 noon. Reservations are required. Reservations may be made by calling 321-783-4441. Due to limited seating, reservations will be limited to 150 people. If you must cancel, please call as soon as possible to allow others to attend. If you wish to **attend by Zoom**, please email Vanessa at vfriedman@seagullbeachclub.com by January 10, 2024.

Second notice is hereby provided that the annual election of the directors of Seagull Condominium Association, Inc. will be held on January 13, 2024. Voting is by written ballot. **ALL ELIGIBLE VOTERS MUST ADHERE TO THE FOLLOWING PROCEDURES IN ORDER THAT THEIR BALLOT IS COUNTED:**

1. The “**2024 Ballot**” lists all those unit owners or other eligible persons who desire to be candidates for the board and who provided proper notice to the association.
2. Enclosed you will also find information sheets provided by the candidates. Please be advised that the association is not allowed by statute to edit, alter or otherwise modify the content of the information sheets and has no liability for the content of the information sheets.
3. Mark in the space provided your desire to **vote for not more than TWO (2) candidates.** Any ballots indicating votes for more than 2 candidates will be invalid.
4. **Place the folded ballot in the smaller envelope marked “BALLOT ENCLOSED” and seal the envelope.** Do not in any way mark the envelope or the ballot other than with your votes.
5. **Complete the “Voting Certificate”** indicating your vote for Limited Proxy, disposition of Operating Surplus for 2023 (if any) and reallocation of funds within the Replacement Reserve Fund. Be sure to read the certificate carefully and mark it appropriately. **Make sure that all owners sign and date** the certificate where indicated and **list each week-unit owned** by you.
6. Place the “Voting Certificate” and the sealed smaller “BALLOT ENCLOSED” envelope in the larger self-addressed envelope and seal the larger envelope.
7. **In the space provided on the exterior of the larger envelope, print your name and address and LEGIBLY indicate the identification of the week-unit(s) and sign where provided. If the authorized voter fails to sign the envelope, the ballot will not be counted. In addition, if this information is not LEGIBLE, your ballot may have to be discarded.**
8. The completed ballot may be mailed to the association or hand delivered to the office. The ballots must be received by the association by 8:00 am on January 13, 2024, in order to be counted in the election.

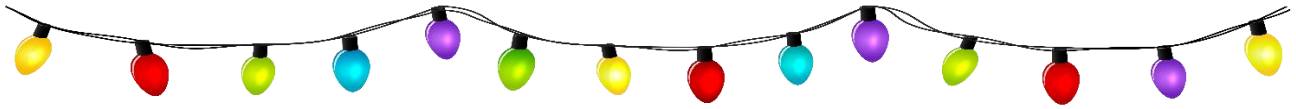

Reminders About the

SEAGULL BEACH CLUB RENTAL PROGRAM

- The Seagull rental program is provided as a convenience to our owners.
 - As always, the maintenance fees must be paid prior to placing your unit(s) in the rental program.
 - Notice of intent to participate in the Rental Pool must be received each year at least 8 weeks in advance of the start of the week being deposited.
 - If you would like to place your unit in the Rental Pool, but have missed the 8-week cut-off date, you may deposit your unit as a Late Rental with Seagull. Late Rentals will only participate in the “pooled” rental income if the number of rental guests for that week exceeds the number of units deposited in the Rental Pool. In that case, Late Rentals will be added to the pool as needed based on the date each unit was deposited as a Late Rental.
 - When an owner deposits their unit in the Rental Pool or Late Rental, they give up their right to use that unit for the entire week – either for themselves or guests.
 - All units in the rental program, whether Rental Pool or Late Rental, are available for use by Seagull for the entire week. In other words, there may be instances where Seagull finds it necessary to move occupants to another available unit for administrative purposes. This move however will have no effect on the original status of an owner’s position in the rental program and their portion of the income from the pool will not be affected.
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
