
Graduates of NLHS have gone on from here to find work and careers in all fields around the world as well as here in North Dakota. We can be proud of, and thankful for, the education received here.







City Music Hall.





New Leipzig has had many fine athletes participating in track events over the years. This year Kary and Shandi Hertz qualified for the State Meet. Kary, a senior, ran the 3200 meters. Shandi, an 8th grader, took 6th at State in the 1600 meters. She also ran in the 3200 meter run.

Many N.L. athletes took part in the State Track meets over the years, but few have set STATE records. Joleen Imhoff, who graduated in 1985, set State records in the 100, 200, and 400 meter runs. Her record of 57. 19 seconds for 400 meters was set in 1985 and still stands in 1994.
