PETITION TO AREA LEGS ASC FOR REGRESS OF A PERSONAL GRIEVANCE

The Tenth Concept is our fellowship's guarantee of respect for the individual trusted servant. This concept may seem self-evident, but our belief in the principle involved is so strong that we want to say it loudly and clearly. Narcotics Anonymous is a spiritual society, with high ideals for how we treat each other. Our members, however, are only human, and we sometimes mistreat one another. The Tenth Concept is our spiritual society's promise that if one of us is wronged in the service environment, the aggrieved trusted servant may ask that the wrong be made right.

. EIGHTH CONCEPT Our service structure depends on the integrity and effectiveness of our communications. Our fellowship's service structure is founded on the unity of our groups; to maintain that union, we must have regular communications throughout Narcotics Anonymous. Together, our groups have created a service structure to meet their common needs and to help them fulfill their common purpose. The effectiveness of the service structure depends on the continued unity of the NA groups, and on their continued support and direction. These things can only be maintained in an atmosphere of honest, open, and straightforward communication among all parties concerned.

My Grievance is that Step Working Guide Discussion Group submitted a motion to ASC, dated 4/13/2023, that is direct violation of the Tenth and Eighth Concepts, by stating that:

1. "The Chair (Ali) has not brought effective leadership since he has been voted in; His reports either "failed" or "tabled" where not business has been achieved." I submit that this accusation is totally wrong and based upon misinformation. The truth is that the Chair is not allowed to or permitted to have **any input, opinion, or decision** about any Report, or any other Decision issued by the Policy Subcommittee. Therefore, it is wrong to state that a report is "His Report, when the chair has absolutely no input, opinion, or decision

in the creation of the report. All the Chair does is read the exact report created by the Policy Subcommittee. If the Report fails or is tabled, it is wrong to blame it on a person who had absolutely no input or opinion in what he simply read to the ASC. It should be noted that the SIXTH Concept and Tradition Two requires that all group decisions must be decided in favor of group conscience, not by any one individual.

2. “Also, the chair did not take direction from motion dated 2/19/23 to cease meeting on Wednesdays to discuss Policy Business.” This statement is also false and based upon misinformation. First of all, the Chair and Policy Subcommittee must take direction from the Traditions, Concepts, and ASC Guideline, first and foremost. The fact of the matter is that this is what the Policy Committee actually did regarding this motion. It was the Policy Committee, without any input, opinion, or decision from the Chair, that determined that the motion dated 2/19/23 was Out of Order because it was passed in violation Guideline 1c, Guideline 27, and because it would require a Policy Subcommittee guideline change. Therefore, the Policy Subcommittee fulfilled its duty set forth in A and B of the purpose of the Policy Subcommittee Guidelines. In any case, once again, it was totally wrong to blame the Chair for the action taken by the Policy Subcommittee, with the chair having no input, opinion, or decision about their action.

WHEREFORE, I respectfully request as a redress for above wrong allegations stated against my integrity in the above motion dated 4/13/23 that: The ASC Chair entertain a motion on the ASC floor, pursuant to Parliamentary Motion procedure #6, to rescind said motion. (since the Chair’s vote was in majority in passing said motion, he is permitted to entertain such a motion in this case.

It should be noted that, regardless of the outcome of this grievance, I (Ali A.), not be able to resume to duties of Policy Subcommittee Chair, Because I have already accepted the position of GSR for Peace in the

Valley. The purpose of this grievance to standup for what is right, and to restore my integrity as a true N.A. Trusted Servant.
