February 9, 2020

We observe the one-minute application of the 11th Step Policy Subcommittee Purpose and Guidelines was read by Carleton P

Minutes were and accepted **Old Business**:

Each month we are going to review and address the structural changes proposed at the Ad-Hoc for exploration of a convention. The Chair will bring the guidelines for Convention Treasurer and Area Treasurer to the next subcommittee meeting. The committee discussed limiting cash transactions: We discussed areas where we can limit cash, such as, registration and using a square card reader. One member questioned where the convention Square card readers were.

New Business: Motion sent to Policy "That the group tally on all "Back to Group" motions be included in the ASC minutes

Policy Chair believed that the motion broke anonymity and that the groups voted in the trusted servant (GSR) and the responsibility of how the GSR votes lie with the group. Policy also wanted to make sure Area didn't send another motion out to the groups that had to be rescinded.


