

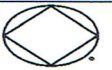

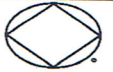

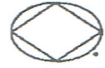

Regional Delegate Report to BRSCNA
February 2020

As we approach the World Service Conference, a great deal of my attention as RD is focused on preparation—learning the conference material so that it is presented effectively and determining how to collect our region's group conscience.

- I attended the CAR/CAT Workshop hosted by the MZFNA in Grand Rapids last month and learned a great deal about the motions in the Conference Agenda Report and the Conference Approval Track. The workshop was led by WB Chair Tana A. and widely attended by RDs, RDAs, as well as RCMs and GSRs from the local areas. My expense report is attached.
- I purchased copies of the CAR for each Buckeye area, as directed by the RSC. WRASCNA's copy was mailed to the area directly, and the others have been hand-delivered to ASCs or RCMs by me directly.
- I attended the WAGS and LEGS area service meetings on January 19 to meet trusted servants, discuss the WSC, and promote our Regional Roundtable events. I thoroughly enjoyed seeing how differently our member areas operate and intend to continue visiting other areas in the region.
- I designed and printed WSC Information Packets and Tally Sheets for each of our homegroups and Tally Sheets for each RCM. We'll be using the Info Packets for our workshop today and can discuss how we want to handle getting these to groups during the Sharing Session. I will submit a motion during New Business to reimburse printing costs.
- Our Regional Report is due next week. I hope to collect information from RCMs during our Sharing Session.
- The Buckeye CAR Workshop will begin at 1pm.
- I will be attending an online meeting about CAT motions next Saturday and a conference online orientation session in March.

Our next Regional Roundtable is scheduled for March 14th and will focus on Public Relations. I suggest we spend some time during our Sharing Session to discuss specifics, as well as plan future Roundtable topics.

Dates for the next World Convention in Australia have been set as Sept 9-12, ²⁰²¹ Most members will need a visa to attend and can apply one year in advance. The site for the 39th World Convention has also been announced as Washington DC in 2024.
