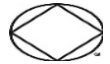


AREA L.E.G.S. MINUTES – SEPTEMBER 20, 2020

F. The Activities Chair left meeting early sick (warranted).

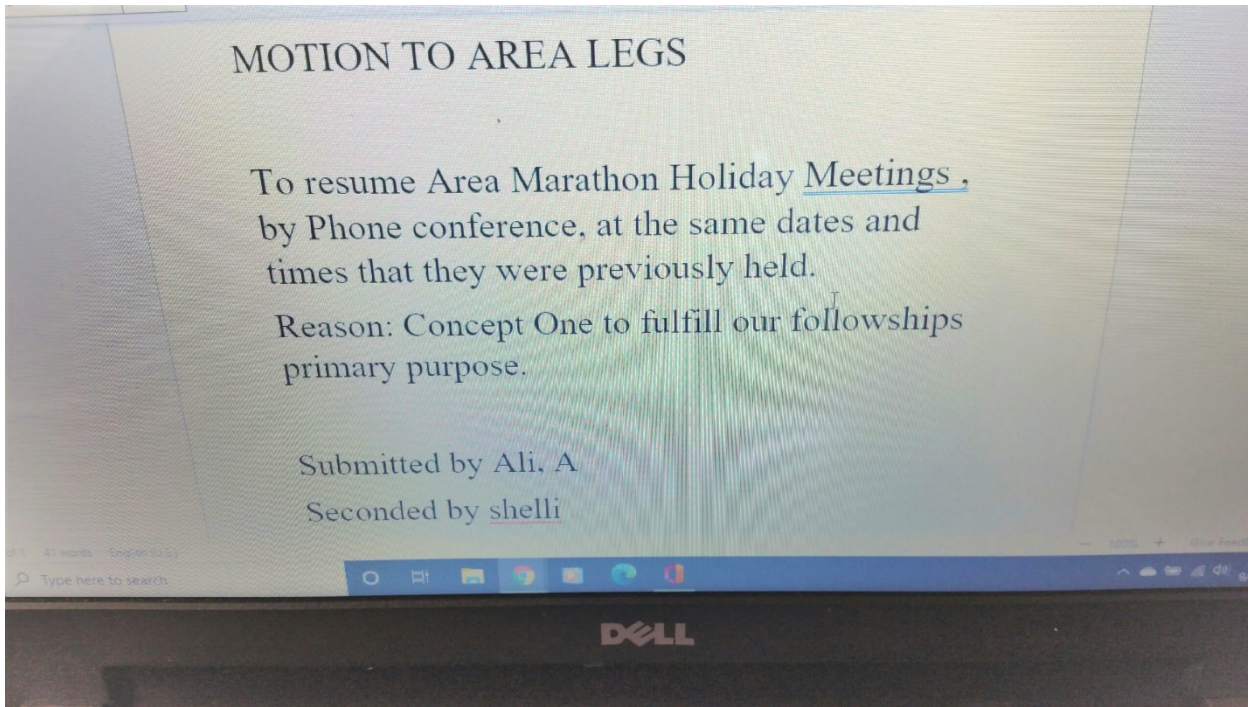
G. The P/R Chair left early for work (warranted).

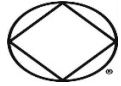

POLICY SUBCOMMITTEE REPORT

September 13, 2020

Meeting opened with a moment of silence and the Serenity Prayer.

We observed a one-minute application of the Eleventh Step

Subcommittee Purpose and Guidelines were read

Subcommittee minutes were read and accepted

Old Business

We finalized the preparation for the September 26, 2020 Policy Learning

Day. The Learning Day on Effective Leadership will begin at 1pm with the Chairperson's

position. Each slot is for a half hour and the speaker will share for 20 minutes to leave 10

minutes for questions and answers. At the end of each half slot that speaker will announce

the next speaker. The Conference Call Line will be monitored by: Ruby K 1:00- 2:15pm,

Walt Mc 2:15-4:00pm, Beverly M 4:00-5:30pm and Rochelle L. will be the opening host

Walt agreed to text GSRs with the Learning Day flyer to be read at meetings and Ruby will

post it on closed social media platforms. A discussion started regarding adding comedy by

having one minutes of comedy during each time slot. But because of a lack of time for

planning to include comedy the committee decided it was not doable for this event.

Monthly follow-up of the Ad-hoc for exploration of a convention

We discussed combining Area Merchandise and Convention Merchandise positions for a

single point of accountability.

New Business: Motion directed to policy from Area meeting

Motion: That as long as we are on the phone line for Area LEGS meetings, we change the quorum from 10 to 7 GSRs. This motion is only in effect while we are doing telephone conferencing. In the past 3 of 5 ASC meetings we have not been able to conduct business because the required quorum of 10 GSRs was

not met. As a result, we could not conduct business which required the GSRs vote. We discussed the motion and some members were against changing the quorum because it will give permission to 7 GSRs to make decisions for the 38 groups in Area LEGS. We voted and the conscious of the members was to add 21b to read: That as long as we are on the phone line for the Area LEGS meeting, the quorum needed to start the Area meeting will be **seven** GSRs and that the conscious can not continue if the quorum of GSRs drops below **five**. This guideline per the motion, is only in effect while the Area meeting is being held on conference call

We discussed reviewing and updating the guidelines for the Position of Webmaster (for the AREA website) so the position can be added to the Area Guidelines and Area Minutes

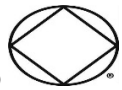

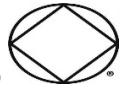

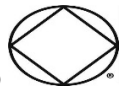
