OLD Business: A member stated his willingness to become a Substitute Chair and was given the information of the qualifications/training to become one.

H&I spent \$149.60 for literature last month.

We are requesting our operating budget of \$50.00 for this month.

We are in communication with the Justice Ctr. as well as the Juvenile Detention Ctr. Concerning a probable meeting in each. Currently the communication is the exchange of guidelines with each of the facilities and the H&I Subcommittee submitting a copy of our guidelines to each. As well as the completion of volunteer application/s.

We discussed purchasing stamps with facility names on each stamp purchased and are in the process of searching for best price prior to purchases.

Old Business
6. Last month's Minutes read and accepted as is.
7. Discussion started with the review of the last extended meeting [Chair left the room] she came back to inform the members there were more thing done since the last ASC meeting to just reading the last report at said meeting and there would be an overall discussion to address those concerns.
New Business
8. Area Review items to be presented to the ASC floor are newly named Activities/Entertainment Subcommittee Guidelines "which includes in the event of a convention" and ASC Guideline #33.
9. We discussed the referred to the Policy Subcommittee motion: "Sharon L.C. not have to pay ASC the money back". [In reference to money paid to Life Exchange Center by Area LEGS] and it was deemed out-of-order via the policy motion log dated 03-18-2007: *Any funds owed to Area LEGS that are not paid within a one month period after notification from the Area Treasurer; their name will be placed on the front of the Area LEGS minutes*]; the process had not been completed prior to the motion being presented.
10. We also addressed the motion from the last ASC meeting and ruled that they are all out-of-order because they violates ASC Guideline #10 - That all Subcommittees of the Area Service Committee will be responsible for submitting new guidelines or changes to existing guidelines to the Policy Subcommittee to ensure that the guidelines fall into accordance with parliamentary procedures and the Twelve Traditions and the Twelve Concepts of NA. [02-10-02 and we will review the changes [along with those listed below] at the Guidelines in the Policy Subcommittee and it's Extended meetings:
 - Motion from Happy Joyous & Free - Printing of Minutes.
 - Motion by Gina W. 2nd by Ali A. Treasurer use of previous form.
 - Motion by Gina W. 2nd by Jimi M. P.O. Box key holder.
11. We dis the Policy Motion Log directives dated 6-19-2016 to remove ASC Guideline #14 which would currently cause 14a.
12. We addressed ASC Guideline #11b. That the Fourth Concept be read after the first statement of willingness or nomination from the floor. [9-16-2012] Explanation: For clarification of effective leadership qualities. Effective leadership is highly valued in Narcotics Anonymous. Leadership qualities should be carefully considered when selecting Trusted Servants. It was noted that at the ASC only the last 2 paragraphs were read and the majority wanted the whole content of the 4th Concept read.
13. The Policy Overview: A Guide to Local Services - page 106 #2 Motion to call the PREVIOUS QUESTION. Also see the MOTION TABLE on page 111 for proper rules of order.
14. There was further discussion on item #12 [see above] and a motion was made by Ronnie C. 2nd Walt Mc. - To reconsider the decision to read the 4th Concept in it's entirety. Explanation: We trust that anyone having the willingness to serve at the ASC level has some knowledge of the 12 Steps, 12 Traditions 12 Concept. Further it exercises prudence so that the ASC can effectively and efficiently carry out the work assigned to it. This reconsideration passed and [read only the last 2 paragraphs of the 4th Concept] will be added to 11b.
15. We close with a moment of silence and the Serenity Prayer.

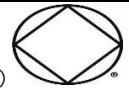

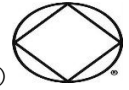

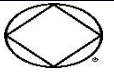
