- 1.) Personal Essay: Please share with the Scholarship Committee -

- Must not exceed 2 pages.
- 2.) Letters of Recommendation: Your letters of recommendation must be from ONE teacher and ONE faculty member OR administrator. They must include the following information in the recommendation letter.
 - How long have they known you and their relationship to you.
 - Indicate your academic achievements, leadership, and/or service.
 - Why you are deserving of the scholarship.
 - Indicate on the letter their full name, title, email address, phone number, signature, and date.

3.) Personal Video:

- Who you are?
- Your reason for pursing higher education.
- How have you demonstrated leadership in your community and school.
- Your career aspirations.

4.) When submitting your information:

- Personal Essay should be in PDF form. If you don't have this capability a word document is acceptable.
- Recommendation Letters should be in PDF form. If you don't have this capability a
 word document is acceptable.
