The Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) still exists throughout the world and most people are still uncertain about the vaccine and side-effects from the vaccines. However, the residents in Belize have shown steady attendance for getting their vaccine. From four hundred to five hundred vaccine doses, now there is shift change to Seven to Eight hundred doses for persons to get the Covid-19 Vaccinations.

Persons eighteen and older are eligible to receive their Covid-19 vaccine. It is important at this time due to the Delta variants.
