

HOW TO AFFILIATE WITH THE ECKAAA CDDO

STEP 1: Any interested provider of IDD services for Coffey, Osage and Franklin counties must first contact the Kansas Department for Aging and Disability Services (KDADS) to apply and obtain a license to provide services. You can call KDADS at 785-296-4986 or go to their web site at kdads.ks.gov.

STEP 2: Once your license to provide services in our area has been received, requests to affiliate with ECKAAA CDDO must be submitted in writing to the CDDO Coordinator. The request to affiliate should include a description of the service(s) the agency intends to provide in the CDDO service area, as well as the structuring of those services. Once the request from a provider is received at the CDDO, the Coordinator will respond to the requests and provide information on what specific documents are needed to complete the process of affiliation.

STEP 3: Providers must complete an application with Kansas Medical Assistance Program (KMAP) to be approved as a Medicaid provider. Visit KMAP's web site at kmap-state-ks.us for the application.

STEP 4: Providers must contract with the State of Kansas Managed Care Organizations. Those are United Health Care, Sunflower Health Care and Aetna. You must contact each company directly to obtain directions on how to complete their provider enrollment process.
