SUMMARY OF CONVERSATION

Chuck FRANKS called on a factfinding mission to determine what USEPA should do regarding the above noted letters from Sarah Mike to John Regan. I explained as follows:

1. J. Regan has had a number of phone conversations with S. Mike regarding these issues.
2. Letters have a dual focus:
  - a. Performance of closed landfill
  - b. Third party sampling at NCEC
3. with regard to performance; J. Regan is now reviewing jar assembly with from closed LF and will determine the most reasonable format to provide data to S. Mike. (S. Mike would like the Dept to be her private consultants) Also - There are no closures exactly like NCEC unlined LF reduction - an imp. point.
4. The Dept. has repeatedly offered to provide guidance for third party sampling and NCEC has stated it's willingness to be cooperative. The issue is one of \$ - who pays for such work - which S. Mike was to direct toward town.
5. USEPA should leave these matters in the hands of NADDES.

Confidences of townspeople should not be undermined in NADDES by the appearance of USEPA checking up on us. Much has been done; NADDES is responsive to concerns and will remain in charge of this project. Summit reluctant ok by Chuck. He would like to be informed if anyone else from USEPA contacts us regarding NCEC issues.
