Below is possible wording for conditions 2 and 3 of the Operation Approval for Phase IV of Stage I of the Consumat Sanco landfill.

- (2) Within five (5) weeks after the effective date of this operation approval the permittee shall have completed removal of all solid wastes from the 5 acre area of the unlined original and single lined extension landfill located northeast of Stage I. Solid waste shall be placed in Phase IV of Stage I or any other permitted facility. Waste to be disposed off-site shall be shipped under a manifest with copies provided to the Department.
- (2)(a) Within three (3) weeks after completion of the relocation of solid waste from the 5 acre area of the unlined original and single lined extension landfill all contaminated soils from the site are to be removed and placed in Phase IV of Stage I or to any other permitted facility. Soils to be disposed off-site shall be shipped under a manifest with copies provided to the Department.
- (2)(b) Within one (1) week after completion of the removal of contaminated soils and verification that all contaminated soils have been removed from the relocation area the site is to be graded and slopes stabilized according to a plan approved by the Water Supply and Pollution Control Division.
- (2)(c) In no event shall the total time frame for the above activities exceed ten (10) weeks from the issuance of the operation approval.

If at any point any of the above time deadlines can not be met, then the permittee shall cease placement of all commercial solid wastes in Phase IV until such time that the existing unlined landfill solid waste relocation project is completed. In order to expedite removal of existing solid waste in the unlined and single lined landfill, the WMD is hereby approving the relocation project to operate during the months of July and August.

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- (3) The permittee shall provide to the Department by 1:00 p.m. each Monday during the waste relocation project a summary of the prior weeks activities. At a minimum, this is to include the air monitoring data; an estimate of the quantity of material relocated and the quantity of material remaining to be relocated; an 8 1/2 inch by 11 inch site plan delineating the areas where removal of waste is completed and the work area for the following week; unusual occurrences, accidents, or nuisance complaints; and weather conditions (rainfall, temperature).

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
